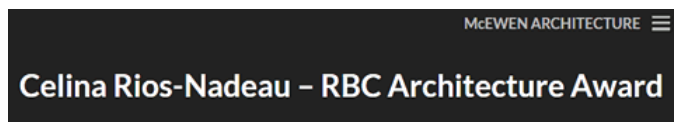
## LCS News Update (Nov. 27-Dec. 1)
