WHAT'S UP IN GRADE 9 SCIENCE?

Grade 9 science students designed an investigation to experimentally determine the density of carbon dioxide gas - they had to figure out how to make the gas in the laboratory, how to collect it, and finally, calculate density. They then determined the percentage error. This pair of students had an all-time accuracy record of 88%! Well done!

The team from 25/7 which included Lockerby student, Sophie St. A. put the grade 9 healthy active living students through a vigorous one hour session of 'Prison Pump.'



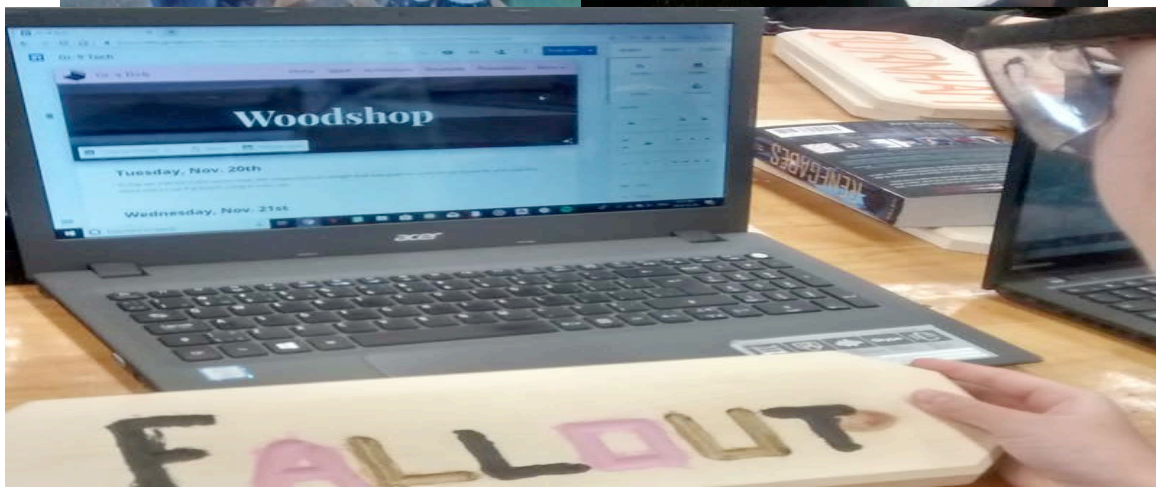
AN EXPERIENCE OF A LIFETIME!

Many of our students have completed and paid for their applications to post-secondary institutions. This message is a reminder that the applications have specific deadlines; it is essential for students to meet these deadlines in order to be considered for their chosen program.

It is also important to note that the institutions will not receive any information until applications have been paid

Early conditional offers are starting to be provided to our students. In order to be considered for this first-round of offers, students must complete and pay for their application prior to the Christmas Break.

Post-Secondary Application Deadlines

University: January 16th, 2019 (\$150.00 fee for 3 programs)
College: February 1st, 2019 (\$95.00 fee for 5 programs)

Students who have applied to University are reminded to access important scholarship details and applications on their individual University Portal. Parents/guardians can also visit the University Portals.

Graduation Gowns

There are only two weeks left for the \$40.00 fee incentive. A number of students have rented their graduation gowns through the Guidance Department. If students are interested in attending our convocation this spring, they are reminded that they must see a Guidance counsellor as soon as possible to rent their gowns. The fee will increase to \$50 after the Christmas Break.

2019 Indigenous Student Awards Program

The RBC Indigenous Student Awards Program was launched in 1992 to assist Indigenous students to complete post-secondary education. This scholarship is intended to support those Indigenous students who have at least 2 years of post-secondary studies. Non-status Indian, Inuit, and Metis are welcome to apply. Selected students will receive up to \$4,000 per academic year for educational and living expenses for 2 to 4 years. The deadline to apply is February 28th, 2019.
