Chief Youth Advisory Council Overview

Responsibilities:

- To give input on GSPS Youth Strategy
- To advise on how GSPS can engage young people to find solutions to youth issues
- To bring forward information on issues/barriers to police/youth relations
- To suggest how to recruit future GSPS members to be reflective of the community
- To provide information for GSPS youth webpage
- To organize events to support the "Courage to Stand" message
- To recommend on funding applications through the Greater Sudbury Police Service Chief's Youth Initiative Fund
- To participate, if personal time and commitment allows, in other GSPS events related to children and youth

Duties of members:

- To attend and fully participate in meetings
- Keep informed on roles, responsibilities and activities of CYAC
- To serve on sub-committees and volunteer at CYAC sanctioned projects/initiatives that require a commitment beyond regular scheduled meeting times
- Sharing information/concerns as appropriate
- Notify the Youth Diversity Coordinator of attendance if unable to attend meetings
- Members are required to arrange their own transportation to and from meetings and events

Meetings:

- CYAC will meet every two weeks on Tuesday, beginning in September and ending in mid- June each year unless otherwise determined. * There will be revisions (i.e.) March break, Christmas break, etc
- Meetings will be held at the Great Sudbury Police Services 5th Floor boardroom from 4:30 PM until 6:30 PM, unless an alternative location or meeting time is required
