




OUR GRADE 9 TECHNOLOGY COURSE IS PRETTY SKETCHY!

Senior visual art students welcomed local artist and Cambrian College professor Johanna Westby into their class on Tuesday morning. Johanna led an exercise in exploring creativity and thinking 'outside of the box,' and talked about how skills in art can be used in a variety of careers. "Creativity is about problem solving," Johanna said, "and you need that in every career."

Johanna is a local artist who is part of a vibrant creative community in Sudbury. She is an illustrator and painter, and has been involved with a number of murals around the city. You will likely recognize the mural below - painted in 2018 on the Sudbury Fire Hall on Van Horne Street - as part of the Up Here Festival.



During her visit, Johanna encouraged students to volunteer at art events like the Up Here Festival and suggested participating in art crawls, visiting local art galleries, and attending shows hosted by art clubs in Sudbury.
