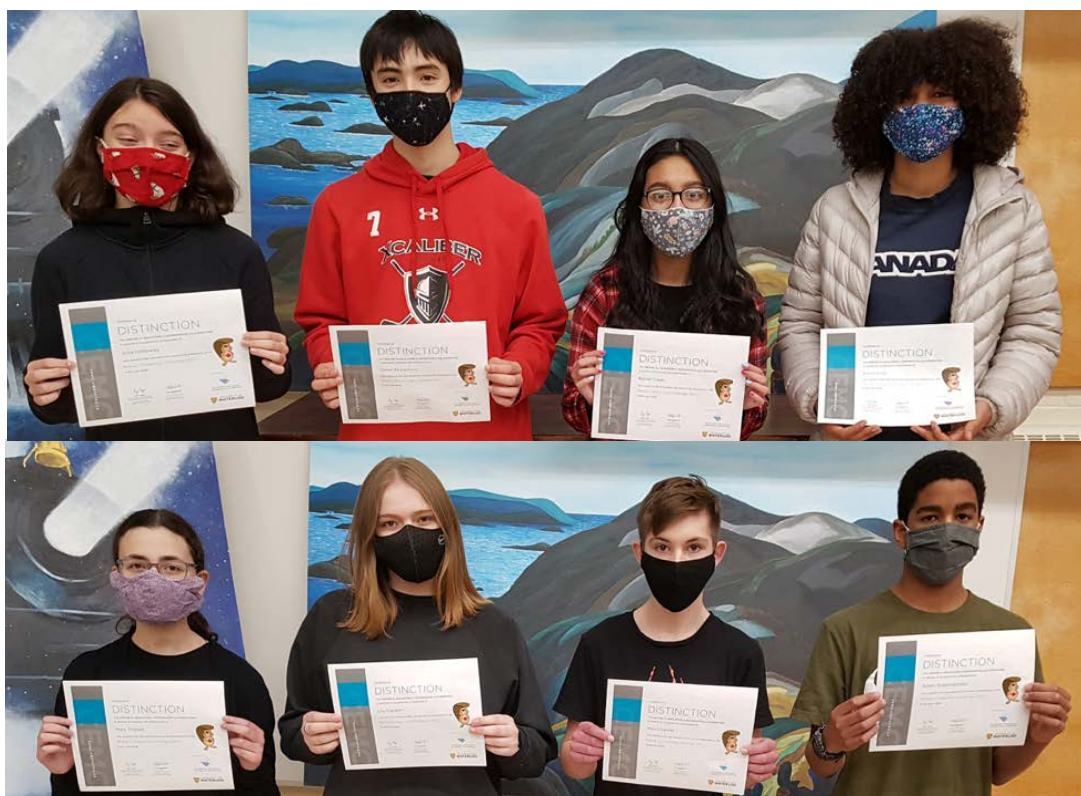

BEAVER COMPUTING CHALLENGE RESULTS

The University of Waterloo's Beaver Computing Competition (BCC) results are in and our Vikings competed with impressive results! Eight students (Mary T., Lilly I., Alex C., Adam S., Julia H., Owen M., Rafiah I., and Avani I.) finished in the top 25% of all participants earning them a certificate of distinction and several others finished just outside of the top 25%.

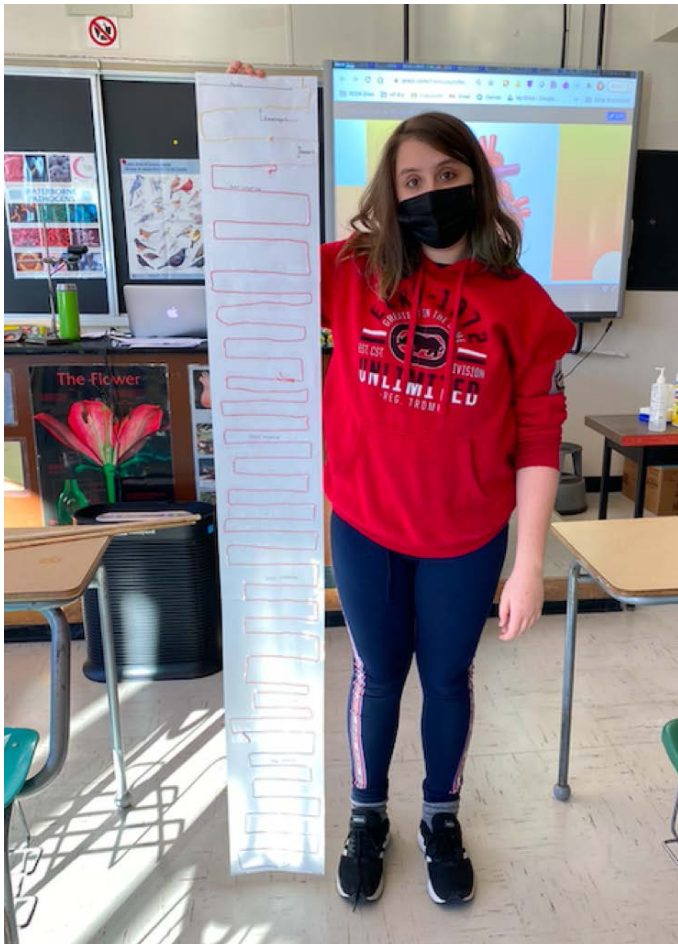

BIOLOGY PARTY!

This week has been 'Body Systems Week' in multiple science classes, and our Grade 11 Vikings kicked it off by doing some digestive system modelling. Our senior Vikings calculated the length of each section of the digestive tract relative to body height, and then estimated its total length...as it turns out...there wasn't much difference between the tallest and shortest students in the class!

Our Grade 10 Vikings spent some time looking at the blood transport system. Our junior Vikings learned how to use sphygmomanometers to measure their blood pressures, collect data, analyze data, and report their findings.

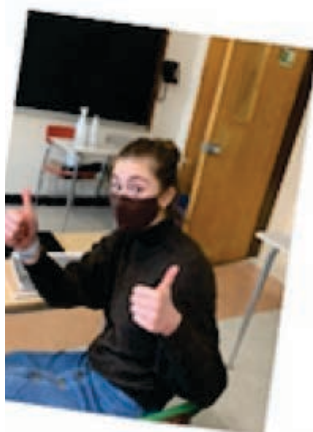

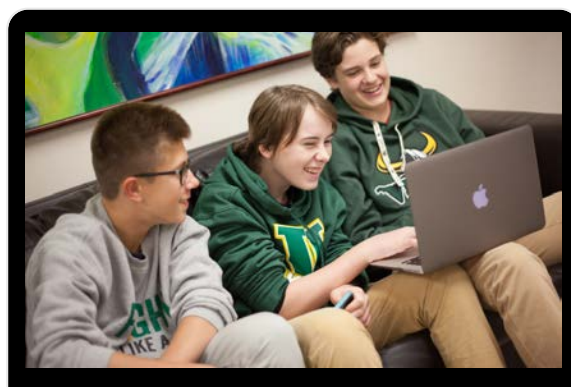
