### LIBRARY SERVICES



## **ONTARIO LITERACY TEST**

The online OSSLT date is still being finalized but the Lockerby Literacy Team has devised a plan of support for our 2021 writers! This year's test is a field test and students who are successful will have it count towards their OSSLT graduation requirement. Also, students will not have to write a news report, respond to an open writing question or read a graphical text in this year's field test. However, students will be tested on the following: reading comprehension; opinion piece writing, multiple choice questions, and short open-response reading. Our Viking community plans to support the students writing the OSSLT this year during Week 1 and 2 Grade 10 and 11 classes. During these Week 1 classes, students will work through a series of online multiple choice exercises that expose students to sample text questions. Additionally, during Week 2 classes, Grade 10 and 11 students will complete a sample practice test in their Literacy Lab workbooks. Teachers will have access to a PDF copy of the workbooks that they can share with their students for those who require it.


