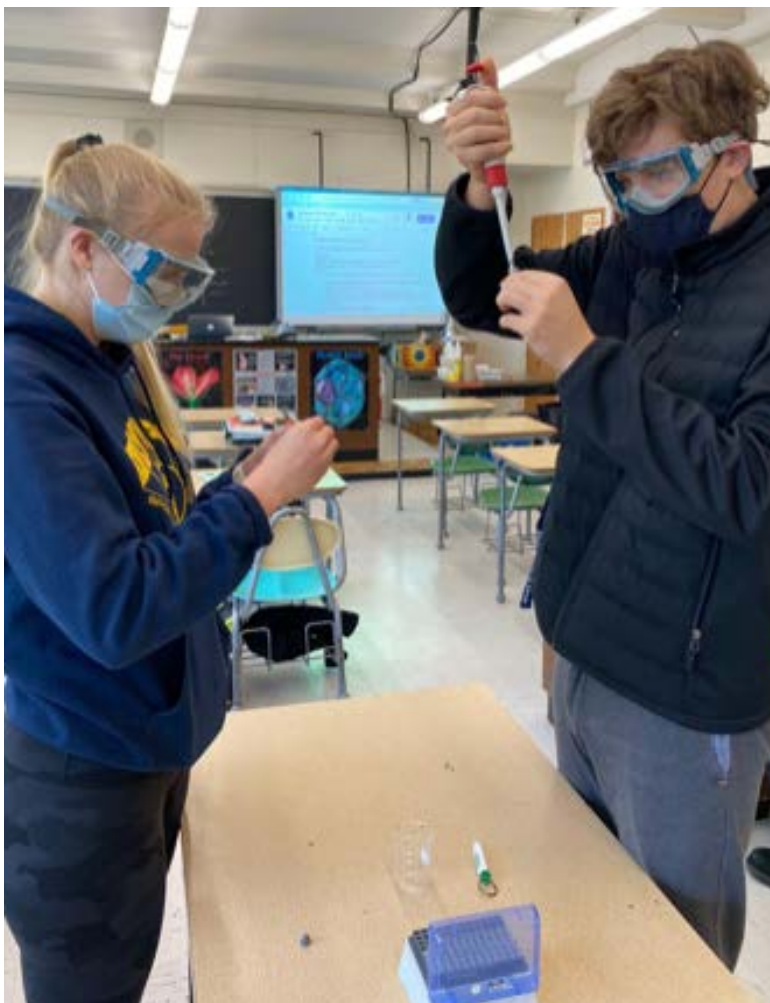

GENETICALLY MODIFIED BACTERIA



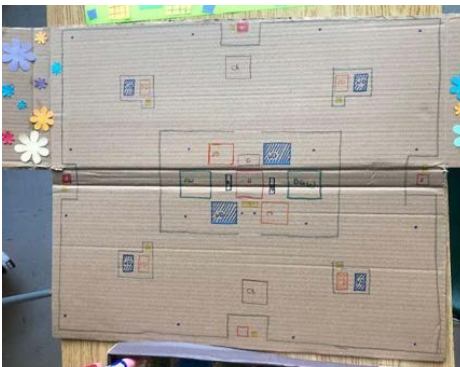
This week the AP Biology class learned about genetic modification, and carried out their own bacterial transformation laboratories. The bacteria were modified with a 'pGLO gene,' which causes them to glow when exposed to UV light. This molecular biology technique can be used for a number of important applications. For example, this is how scientists modify bacteria to make insulin for human use! Judging from the images, it looks like our biologists had successful transformations!

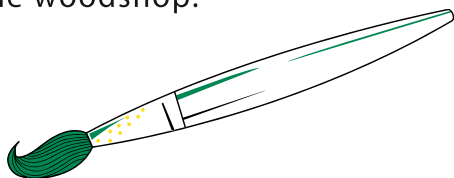
GRADE 12 KINESIOLOGY

This week in intramural action, the Hitmen and the Kin Team dominated the courts in Junior action to take home the win this week! Games will continue next week as the seniors return to the courts!



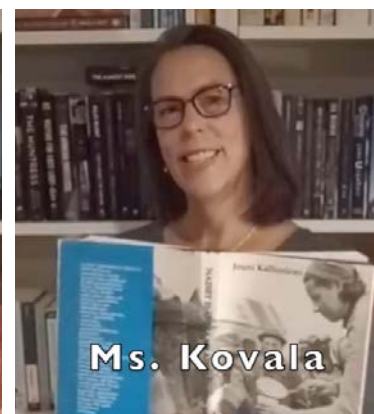
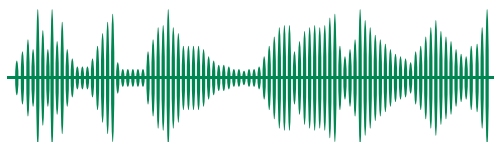
PA DAY

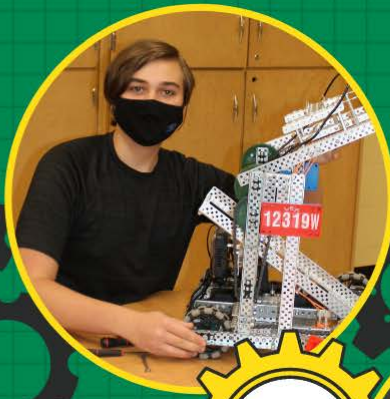

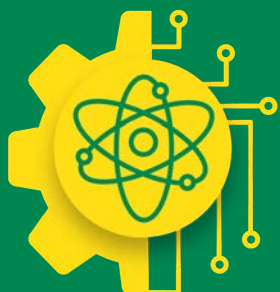
