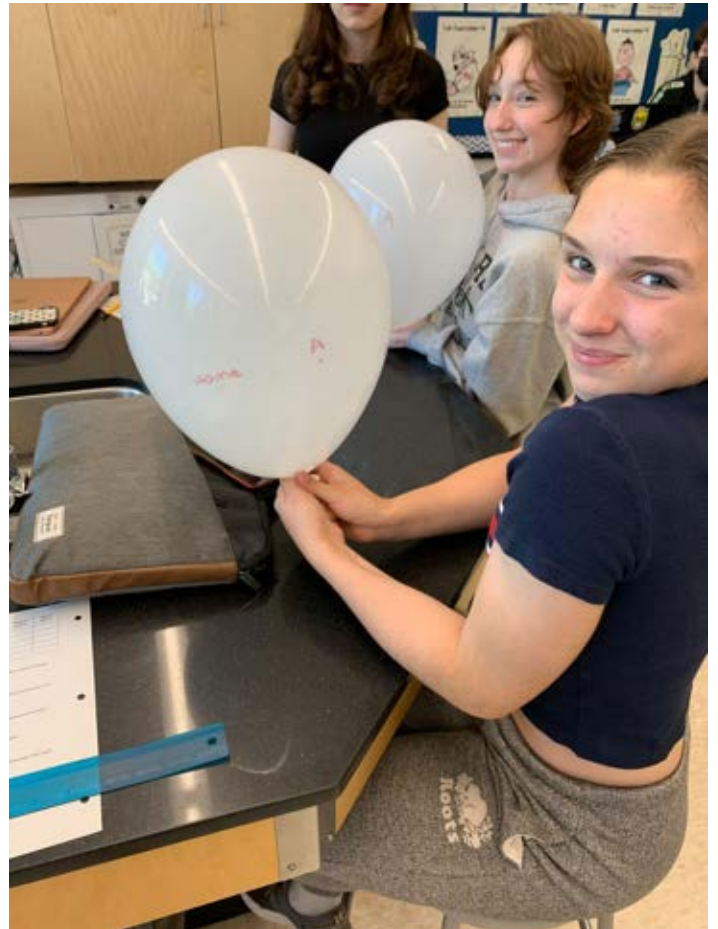
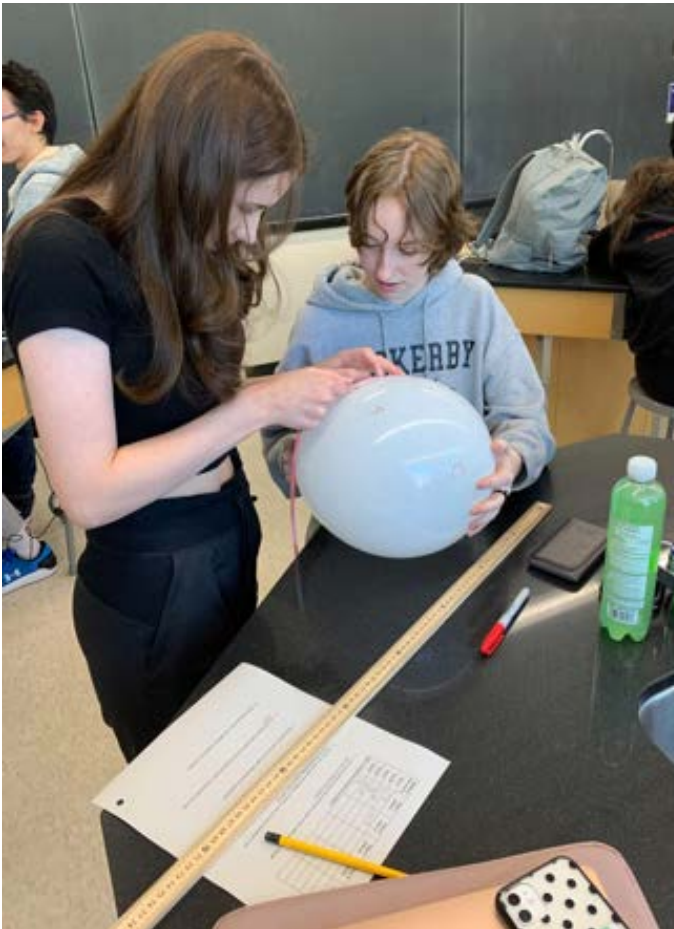

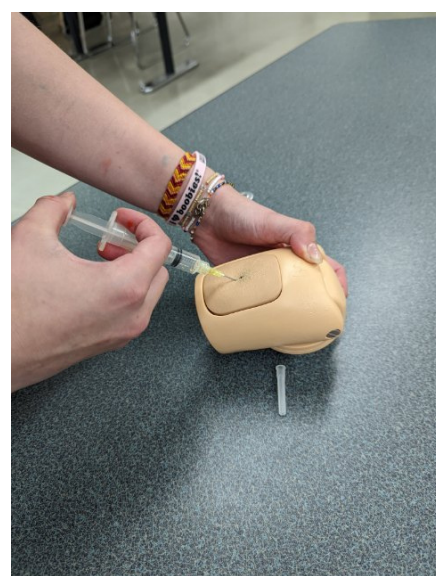
## MODELING THE BIG BANG THEORY

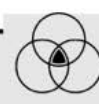

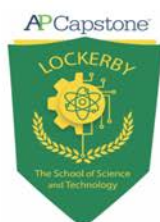

- Some in-class examinations and culminating activities components will be administrated on different dates from those indicated below. Students are asked to please confirm those dates with each teacher.
- Absence due to illness requires a verified doctor's note (please reference our Assessment and Evaluation Policy for further information).
- If a student is late for an examination, they must get an admit slip from the Main Office.
- Buses arrive and depart at the usual time. Students are not permitted in the hallways during examinations.
- Students are not allowed to access their locker while other students are writing examinations in that area.
- The Library is designated as a quiet study area.
- Notebooks, textbooks, and electronic devices must be left in the designated area in the examination room.

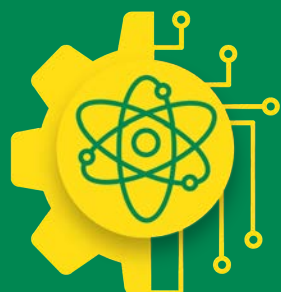
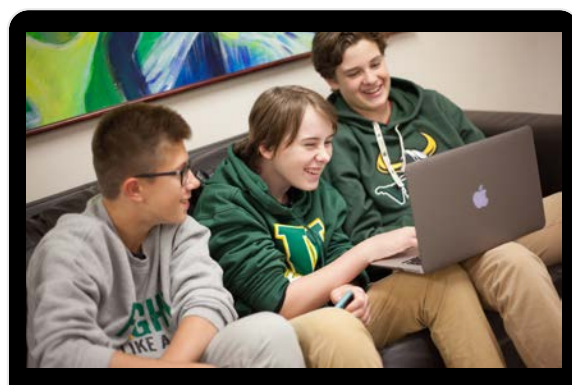
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
