Through her involvement in extra-curricular activities, such as NaNoWriMo, the Viking Voice, Skills Competition Ontario, our school ceremonies, and Sampo Rhythmic Gymnastics (to name only a few), she enabled Viking students to fulfill their aspirations. YEAR-END HOUSEKEEPING ITEMS

Having said that, and as the school year quickly comes to an end, there are a few important housekeeping items that remain:

Final Examinations

The end of the school year is only a few days away, which means that students are or have finished preparing for their final culminating activities and examinations. Each course will have different final evaluation(s) depending on its course content. For those courses with an examination, a final schedule can be found on the next page. The last day that examinations have been scheduled is Tuesday, June 28th, 2022.



School Item Returns

Lockerby Composite School has loaned several materials to our Vikings students this past school year. We are asking that all of these loaned items now be returned to the school. If students have final examinations next week, they can return all items then. In order to prepare for the next school year, students are required to return items such as:

- technology (eg. iPads, chromebooks, cameras, etc.)
- textbooks
- English books
- laboratory equipment
- woodworking, auto, and technological equipment
- physical education equipment/sportswear
- borrowed visual arts supplies
- · musical instruments
- · Library books

When returning items, students are asked to visit the Main Office. Office Staff will be on-hand to collect all materials.

During the examination period, students will be unable to access your lockers while other classrooms are writing. Books, bags and coats will remain at the front of the classroom where you will be writing your exams.




Grade 9 - 11 Report Cards will be mailed to all homes by the second week of July.

- Notebooks, textbooks, and electronic devices must be left in the designated area in the examination room.


First day of the 2022 -2023 school year: September 6th, 2022




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
