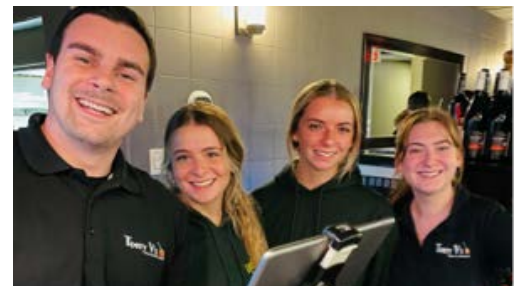

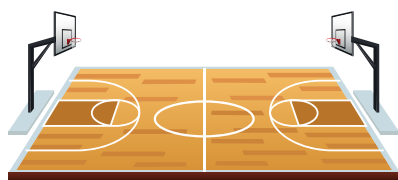
Flag Football


Grade 12 Information



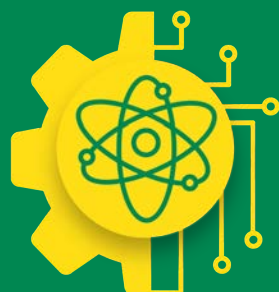
