
## INJURY TAPING CLINIC

#### **GRADE 11 MEDICAL BIOLOGY**










#### LITERACY TEST UPDATE





#### **Grade 12 Information**

College and University Applications

On Monday, November 28th, 2022 during Period 3 (Room 127), Student Services will be hosting a step-by-step look at how to apply to college. Students are encouraged to have between 3 - 5 program choices ready for this day, for those applying to college. If you have any questions or concerns please do not hesitate to contact the Student Services Department. Additional information for college applications can be accessed through OCAS (Ontario College Application Service). Many of our students have already completed and paid for their applications to postsecondary institutions. This message is a reminder that the applications have specific deadlines; it is essential for students to meet these deadlines in order to be considered for their chosen program. It is also important to note that the institutions will not receive any information until applications have been paid. Early conditional offers are starting to be provided to our students. To be considered for this first-round of offers, students must complete and pay for their application prior to the Holiday Break.

University Deadline: Thursday, January 12th, 2023 (\$156.00 fee for 3 programs) College Deadline: Wednesday, February 1st, 2023 (\$110.00 fee for 5 programs)
