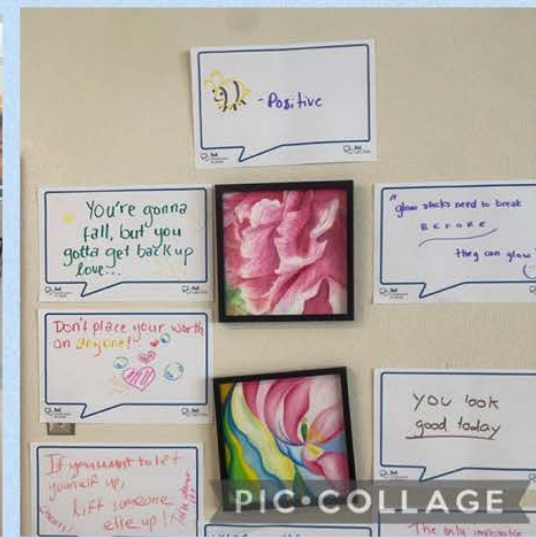

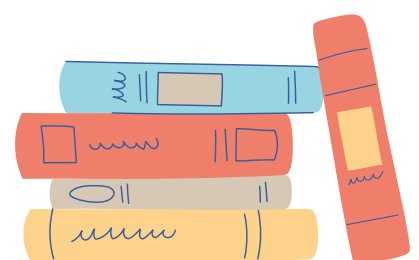

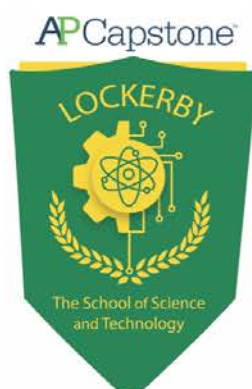

Norah M. - 1st in 50m Freestyle & 100m Freestyle

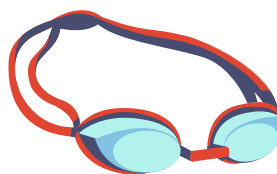
