STAND-UP AGAINST BULLYING

This past Thursday, Lockerby Composite students and staff wore pink for 'Stand Up Against Bullying Day.' This annual day began in Nova Scotia where secondary school students Travis Price and David Shepherd arranged for dozens of their classmates to wear pink shirts in support of another student who had been bullied for wearing pink. The Province of Nova Scotia subsequently declared the second Thursday at the start of every school year to be 'Stand Up Against Bullying Day.' This day allows our community to create a culture where all people feel safe, valued and respected, regardless of age, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, ability, or cultural background.

Some highlights include an Eastern Red-backed Salamander, a deadly poisonous Destroying Angel mushroom, and a tiny fish called an Iowa Darter. Students took some great photos and plan to display them along with information about our 'finds' for other students at Lockerby to enjoy.




THIS WEEK IN VIKING ATHLETICS...


