## LU COMPUTER SCIENCE & ENGINEERING

On Tuesday, students from our Computer Science and Mining SHSM programs as well as students from our Computer Science courses visited Laurentian University. The first field trip stop was in the Computer Science Department where students learned details about the BCosc degree and different courses and specialization options. While there, Voyageur students demonstrated one of the video games created in their Game Design course. Students then visited the Engineering Department to learn about the three types of engineering majors available at Laurentian – Chemical, Mechanical, and Mining. Students also looked at a few demonstrations in the engineering labs including vibration testing, the use of mycology to clean tailing pond water, and the use of a wind tunnel in mine development. 


