LOCKERBY ROBOTICS (CONTINUED)



It's time to finalize details and complete payment. Parents/guardians are encouraged to review the applications with their student in the evening after the application has been completed. <u>Post-Secondary Application Deadlines</u> University: Monday, January 15th, 2024 (\$156.00 fee for 3 programs) College: Thursday, February 1st, 2024 (\$125.00 fee for 5 programs)

To prepare for this process, students are asked to ensure they are able to log into the myBlueprint software and begin to look at options for the upcoming 2024 - 2025 academic year. If your student is having trouble accessing the software they are asked to come to the Student Services department for assistance.
