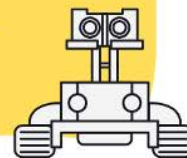

Marks were sent to Ontario colleges and universities on Thursday, February 7th, 2024. Students are asked to check their OCAS and OUAC accounts to ensure that all of their courses and marks have been transferred. Students should also be checking their individual post-secondary portals (i.e., Cambrian College and/or Laurentian University).

Last Call - Graduation Gowns - February 27th, 2024

The final day for students to be able to reserve their graduation gowns is Tuesday, February 27th, 2024. The rental fee for each graduate will be \$50.00. Students can reserve their gowns using our School Cash Online.

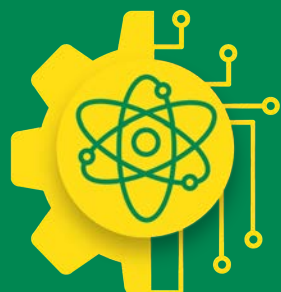
