

LOCKERBY'S CONCERT BAND


Although it may be a new semester, our Concert Band was still working hard this week as they spent some time practicing for the Northern Ontario Music Festival!

Basketball



This year's prom will be held on Thursday, June 13th, 2024 at Science North. Student Council will be selling tickets for the event in the next few months.


Convocation - Monday, June 17th, 2024




