
## **MIDTERM REPORT CARDS**



#### Accept Your College Offer – Wednesday, May 1st, 2024

Students should accept their college offer by Wednesday, May 1st, 2024 to save their seat in their chosen program. If a program is over subscribed and there is a waitlist, students risk losing their place in the program if they do not adhere to this deadline. Students can accept their programs on the Ontario College Application website - ontariocolleges.ca. If they have any questions or concerns they are asked to see Ms. Baggs or Mrs. Beaudry.

#### University Applications - Important Dates

As of Wednesday, May 29th, 20234 every student who has applied to a university program will have received a response from an Ontario university. A response will be either i), an offer, ii) a refusal, or iii) a deferral pending the receipt of specific additional information.By Monday, June 3rd 2024, Ontario universities require a response to an offer and most likely a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.). Note that all other admissions-related elements including scholarships, student assistance or financial incentives, and residence are part of the offer of admission.

Students must also log into their OUAC accounts to accept their offers; this is a multi-step process. Students will receive a confirmation number once all of the steps in the process are completed. A video tutorial for online responses is available on the OUAC website. This video demonstrates the steps required to respond to a university offer of admission. (https://www.ouac.on.ca/ugrad-tutorials/#respond). When you successfully complete the submission process, you will immediately receive a confirmation number online. You will also receive the confirmation number by email along with a summary of your responses to offers of admission and/or changes to your application information.Important: if you do not immediately receive a confirmation number, your response was not saved. You then must log back into your online application and re-submit your response.


