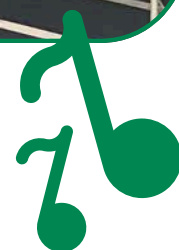

MUSIC FESTIVAL SEASON

It's Festival Season for Lockerby Musicians! A huge congratulations goes out to the Music Department for their wonderful performances at the Northern Ontario Music Festival last week! The Wind Ensemble was awarded a rating of silver plus and our 50 person Concert Band performed a wow-ing performance and received a rating of gold! Both our Wind Ensemble and Concert Band received an invitation to compete at Musicfest in Toronto! Our Jazz Combo was also rewarded with a silver rating for their efforts!

On Wednesday, Lockerby Composite School hosted the Sudbury Music Festival (SMF)! Music students from École St. Pierre, Princess Anne Public School, St. Benedict's Elementary School and Lasalle Secondary School came to share their music making skills with Aaron Hodgson, a trumpet player and professor at the Don Wright Faculty of Music at Western University.

At this year's SMF, our Concert Band was awarded a mark of 84 and a rating of silver, while our Jazz Combo was awarded a mark of 83 and also received a rating of silver. Our Wind Ensemble was the last of the school groups to perform and the adjudicator praised our crew for their attention to details and their precise sound. As such, our Wind Ensemble was awarded a mark of 85 and a rating of gold! That rating of gold was the only one given out that day! Congratulations on amazing accomplishments!

SUDBURY REGIONAL SCIENCE FAIR

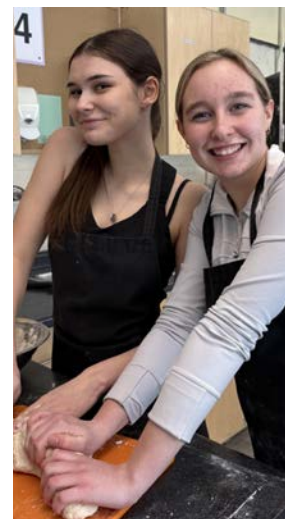
