






#### LIGHTS, CAMERA, ACTION!






#### PARENT/GUARDIAN HANDBOOK

#### **Final Examinations**

#### **School Item Returns**

#### Lockers






#### **EQAO MATHEMATICS (GRADE 9)**


#### Track and Field



#### **New Credit eLearning Courses**

- Students are permitted to enroll in only ONE summer eLearning course.


