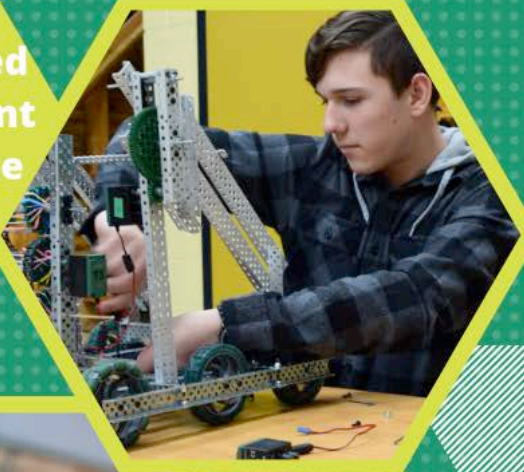

#### Post Secondary Applications

A message to our Grade 12 students: Make sure you have a plan!

The Guidance team will be supporting Grade 12 students from November 29<sup>th</sup> - December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Students are reminded to sign-up for a session if they have not already done so. The college application deadline is February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 and the university application deadline is January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019.

It is very important that students remember to pay for their applications. The applications will not be activated until fees are received.

#### Graduation Gowns

The order for this year's graduation gowns will be placed prior to the Christmas Break. Students must rent a gown in order to participate in this year's June Convocation ceremony. The fee for the gown rental is \$40.00 prior to the Christmas Break. The fee will increase to \$45.00 after the Christmas break. Students can place their order with a Guidance counsellor.
