Our Junior Boys Volleyball team hit the court this past Wednesday for their first game of the year. They lost a close 5-set match, but the season certainly looks promising for the team!

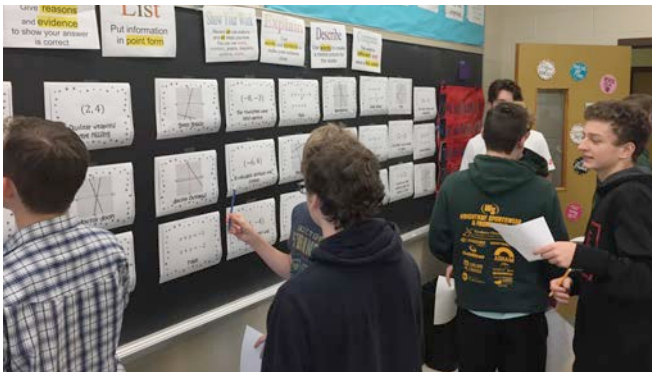

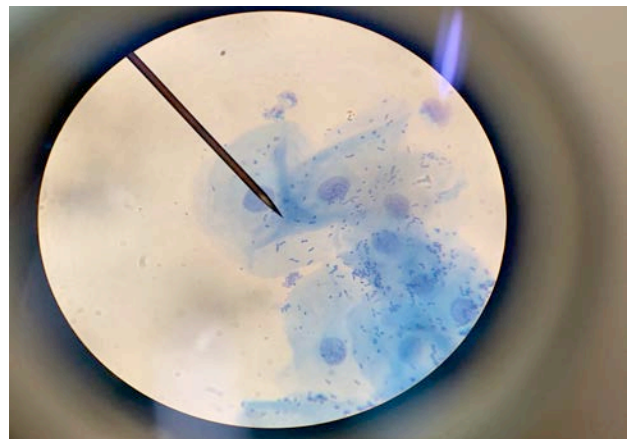
WHAT'S HAPPENING IN STEP BIOLOGY (PART I)?

This week, our biology students wrapped-up 'Bacteria Week' by examining the spread of tuberculosis in Russian prisons. They learned how antibiotic resistance develops, and modeled this by running their own prisons, with 'sticky note' inmates. Some students were prison doctors, doling out antibiotics, and others were prison wardens, determining who got infected. They were able to see how easily infections are spread in high density populations, and how difficult it is to cure multi-drug resistant diseases!



WHAT'S HAPPENING IN STEP BIOLOGY (PART II)?

This week, our biology students also observed their own personal bacteria (as part of 'Bacteria Week'). In the process, our students learned some important microbiological techniques: they learned how to swab, fix, and stain a bacteria sample. Students then used high magnification lenses to observe their bacteria, and were able to classify cells based on their shapes. Some students even took photos of their own bacteria using their phones - you can see the following image has cheek cells, and a number of different much smaller cells that are bacteria.

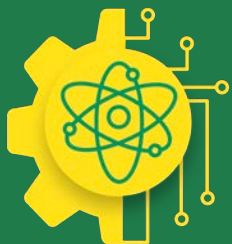
