In fact, they identified red and jack pines, white birch, red maple, chokecherry, trembling and large tooth aspen, and mountain ash, to name a few!

This week, students in grade 9 STEP Science demonstrated their knowledge of scientific controls and variables by competing to complete a digital escape room activity in the fastest time. Our Vikings had to answer a number of questions and complete a number of riddles to unlock virtual questions.

O-WING GLIDERS AND THE SCIENTIFIC METHOD

Grade 9 STEP Science students created a number of O-Wing gliders with different wing and fuselage sizes on Thursday. Our Vikings then flew their gliders outside to measure their flight path and the distance flow. They will use the data collected to generate graphs of their results and apply the steps of the scientific method to identify which O-wing glider flew the best!


STUDENT SERVICES

LIBRARY SERVICES

Lockerby Composite School's Library is pleased to be able to continue to offer services to staff and students this September. 
