



LCS LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE

This week students in our Grade 11 Architecture course are putting the finishing touches on their residential landscape designs! Armed with new knowledge of plant hardiness zones and botanical nomenclature, Hunter has designed a great landscape complete with a patio, pool, and arbour.





AP BIOLOGY

This week, our AP Biology students learned about communication between cells, which is extra important in the endocrine and nervous systems. We dissected sheep brains, and differentiated between white and grey matter. Our Vikings located some key brain structures including hypothalamus, pituitary, cerebellum, and brain lobes. We then dissected sheep eyeballs and were able to locate the optic nerve, lens, retina, and other structures. Talk about an eye opening experience!









GRADE 10 FRENCH IMMERSION


REPORT CARD DISTRIBUTION

Additionally, students enrolled in an asynchronous Physical Education or Technology course will have their midterm report card digitally emailed to them through their rscloud.ca email account.




LIBRARY SERVICES
