NEW TECH/OLD TECH

Taking in full advantage of new technologies, Teagan methodically createD the design for her woodworking project, this week. Her plans will come to fruition using the more traditional tools and materials in the woodshop. What a great combination of technologies!



MEDICAL BIOLOGY

This week Vikings wrapped-up their genetics unit by applying what they learned in class to solve real-life problems. First, students solved a paternity mystery by testing blood samples, and applying the principles of inheritance to blood types. Then, students examined how a detrimental trait such as sickle cell anemia can persist in a population if there is selective pressure for it. Our Vikings modelled this persistence by using beans to represent chromosomes, and a coin toss to represent the possibility of contracting malaria. Students learned that an understanding of genetics certainly helps explain the world around us!



VISUAL ARTS

Our Grade 11 Vikings have been very busy this month! After wrapping-up a figure study unit, they took on the challenge of a textured mural and then moved into a landscape unit. After hard work and determination, our Viking artists have produced some wonderful work. 



NEW CNC/CAM TECHNOLOGY

Lockerby has some new woodworking technology to incorporate into woodworking projects! Now our Vikings are able to create a design in Fusion 360 and have the software create 16,000 lines of computer code to have a machine accurately mill-out their design! 
We are just learning to use this technology, so who knows what will be created next!?



Early conditional offers are starting to be provided to our students an in order to be considered for this first-round of offers, students must complete and pay for their application prior to the Christmas Break.

University Application Deadline: January 15th, 2021 (\$150.00 fee for 3 programs) Students can research various university programs throughout Ontario as well as complete their applications at - http://www.ouac.on.ca

College Application Deadline: February 1st, 2021 (\$95.00 fee for 5 programs)




LIBRARY SERVICES
