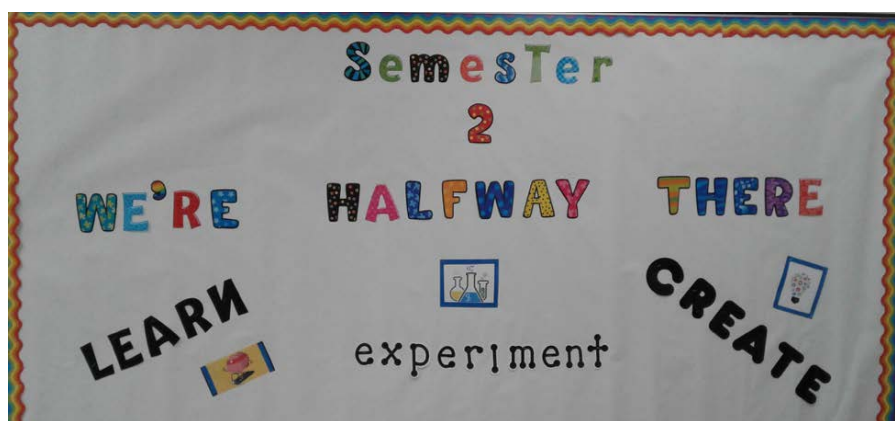

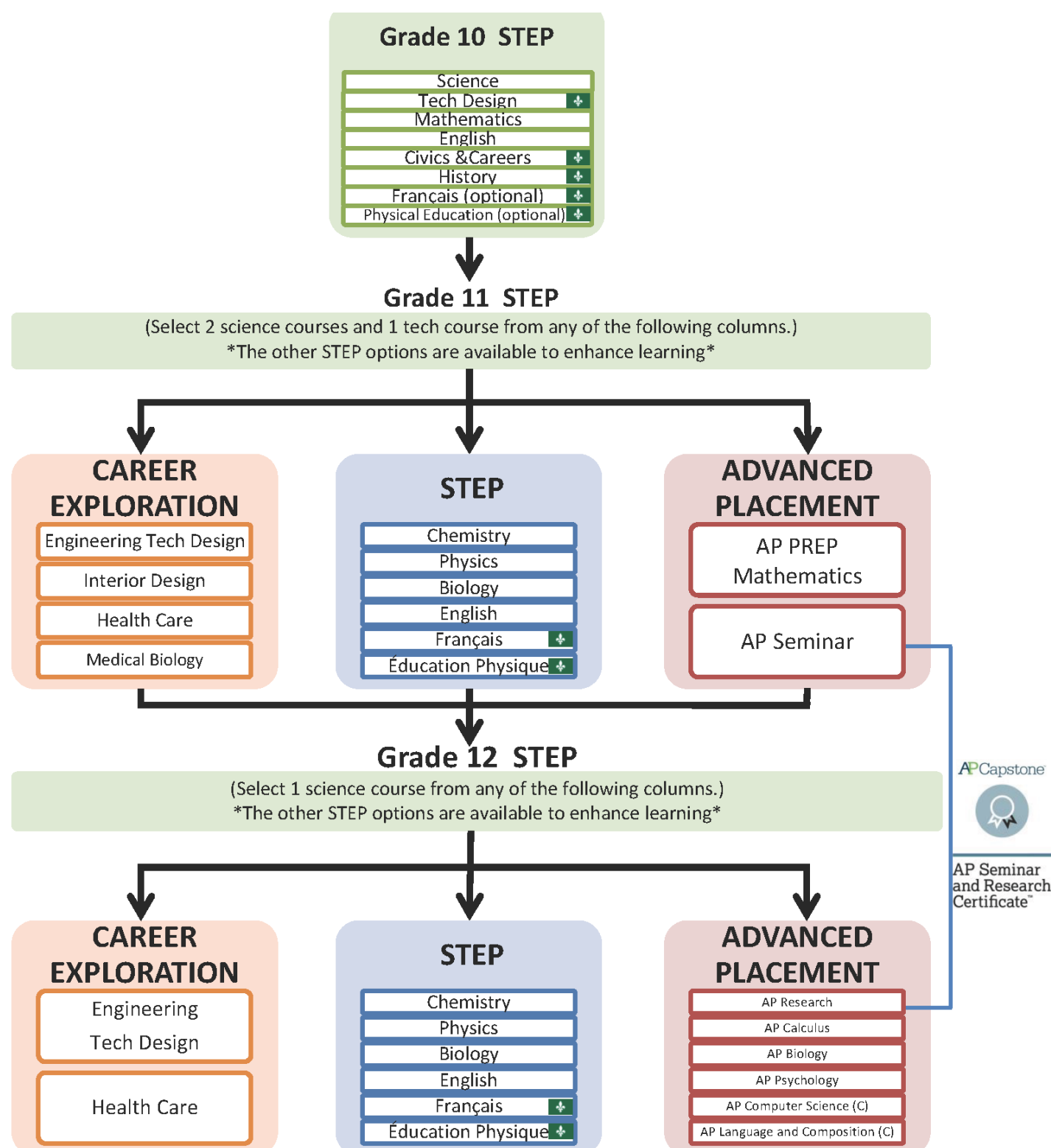
Please do not forget that Semester 1 materials and equipment must also be returned to the school during those times.

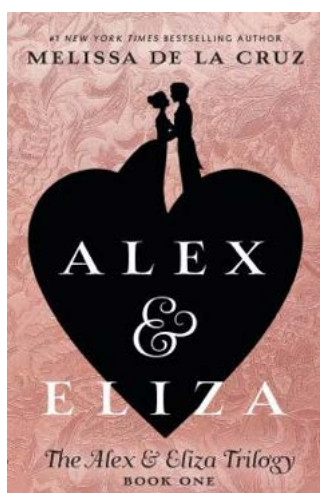

Post-Secondary Applications

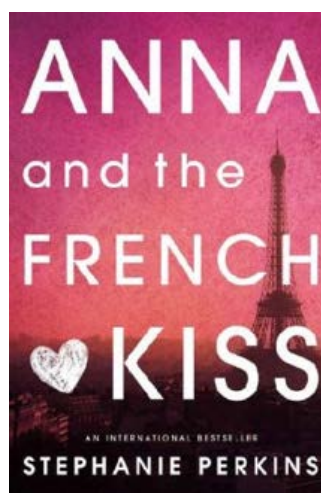

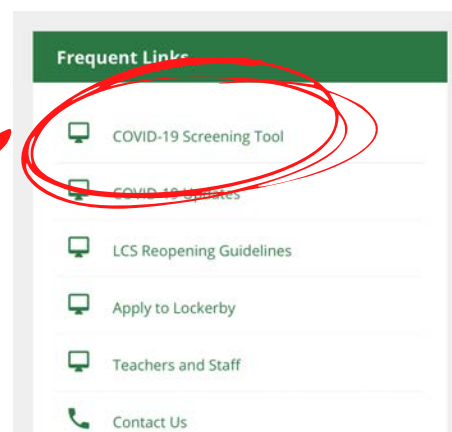

RE: SCREEN FOR COVID-19 AS PART OF YOUR MORNING ROUTINE

Dear Parents/Guardians:

The start of the new semester in our secondary schools is an opportune time to remind parents/guardians and students to screen for COVID-19 as part of your morning routine.

Before leaving home for school, it's important that students self-screen for symptoms by using the online school screening tool that can be accessed at the following link:

NEW: The Ministry of Education now requires that secondary schools confirm with students that they have completed the self-screening tool before leaving home daily. This will be done during first period attendance. Please post a note on the fridge or set a daily reminder to screen for COVID-19 each and every day **BEFORE** leaving for school.

Self-screening, wearing masks, washing hands, physical distancing and maintaining cohorts are all part of the health and safety protocols in place to limit the spread of COVID-19.

Students must stay home from school if they are sick, have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19, have been advised by a doctor, health care provider or Public Health to self-isolate, and/or have travelled outside of Canada in the last 14 days.

Let's take care of ourselves and take care of each other.

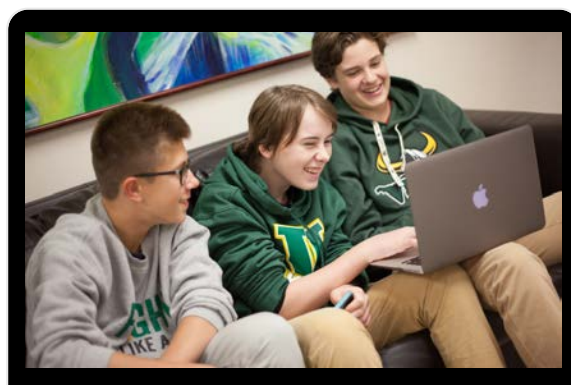


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
