



Midterm Mark Transmission to Colleges and Universities

The Rainbow District School Board will be sending marks to colleges (OCAS) and universities (OUAC) beginning Thursday, April 22nd, 2021. Students should review the transmission carefully to ensure the details are accurate. Special attention should be taken with regards to course codes and midterm marks. If there are any errors or questions please email Mrs. Beaudry.

Students are also reminded that they must accept an offer to their chosen program carefully. The acceptance procedure is a multi-step process and must be completed with care. Each website has very specific instructions that must be followed. Students are encouraged to read the guidelines with care as well as watch training videos.

College Accepting an Offer

Applicants must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission by Saturday, May 1st, 2021. This deadline includes students who are planning to attend the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Programs. Visit the OCAS website for additional details.

University Accepting an Offer

Monday, June 1st, 2021, is the earliest date Ontario universities may require a response to an offer of admission and a financial commitment of any kind (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit). Visit the OUAC website for additional details.


