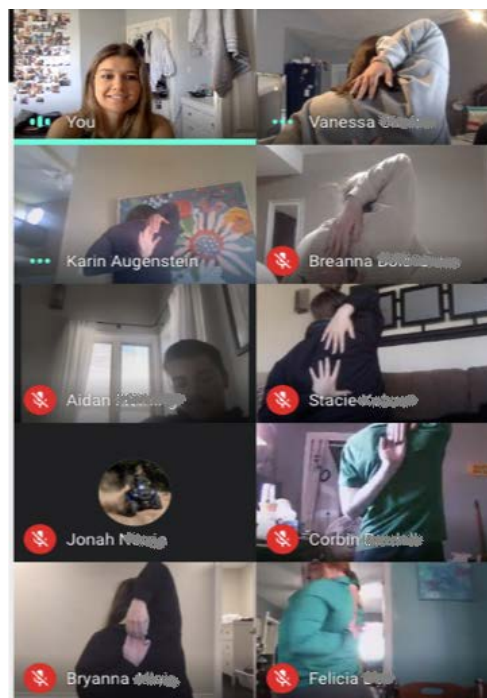
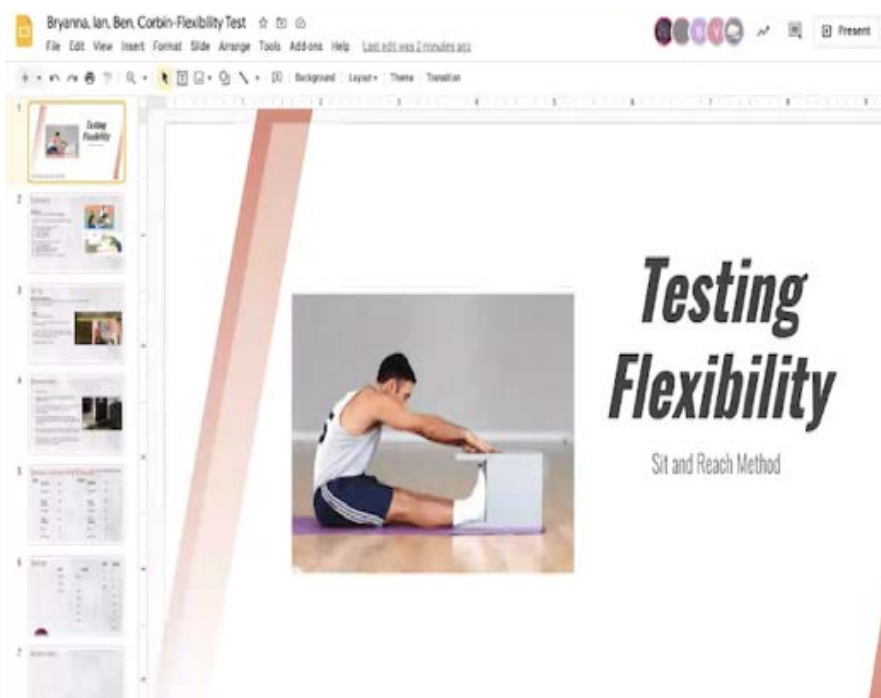
PROJECTS DESTROYED!!!

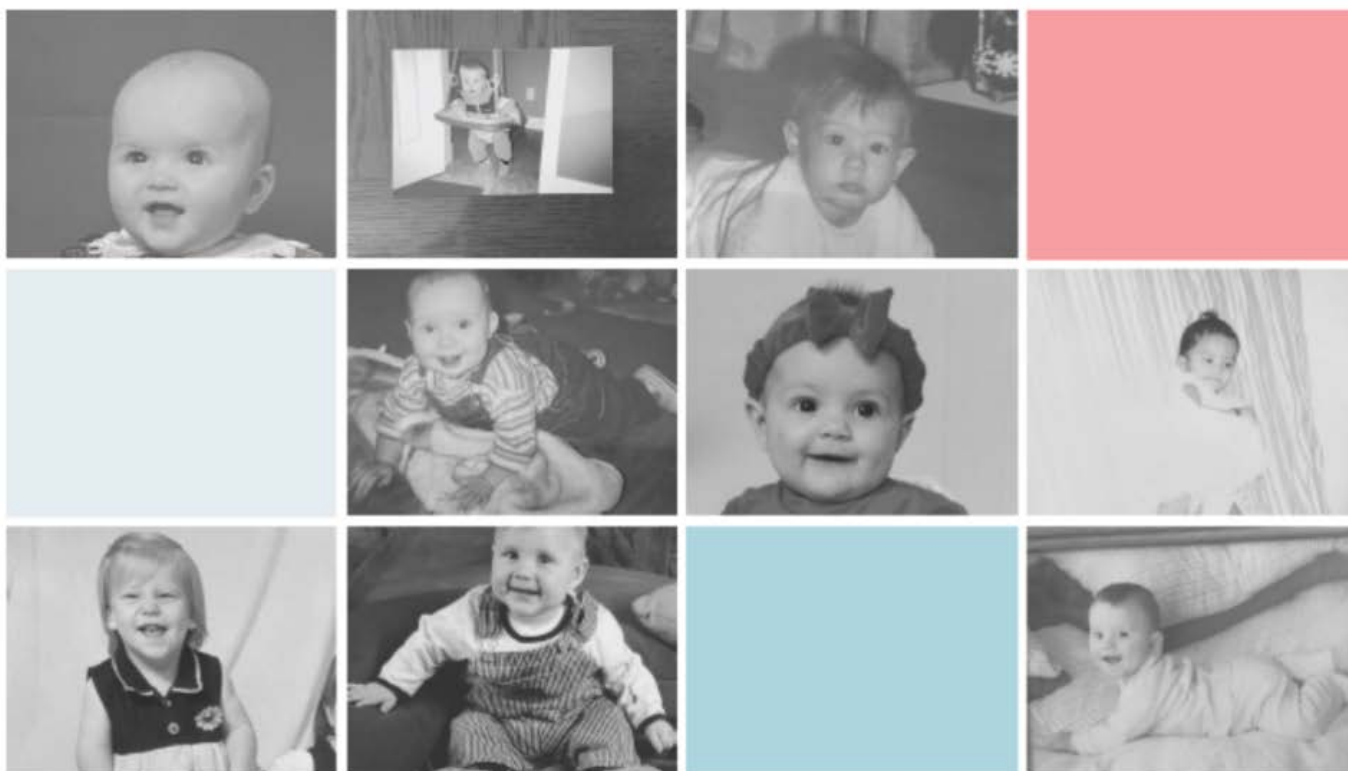
ONTARIO SKILLS UPDATE!

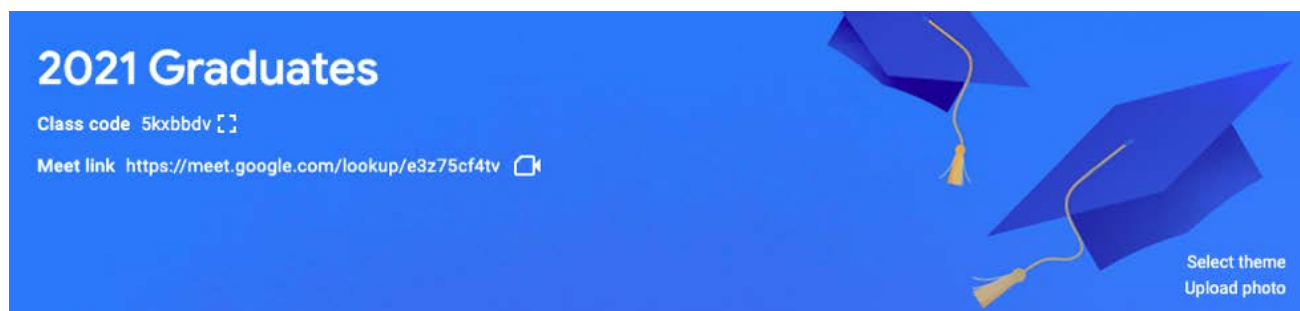

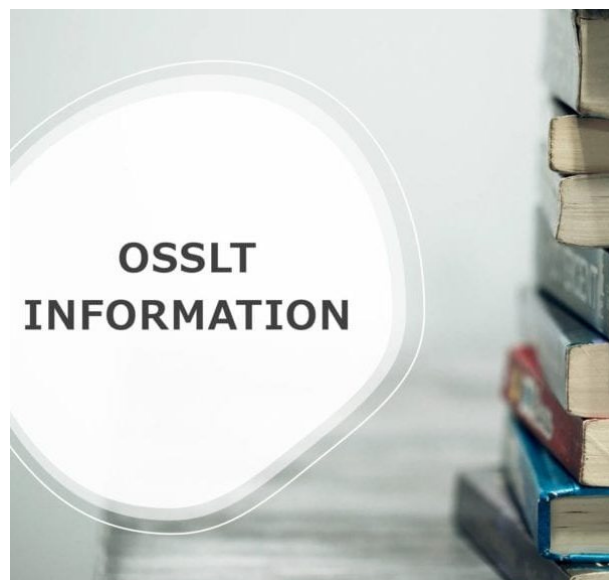
Digital Downloads - Examinations Information

Here are some essential preparation steps prior to completing Digital AP Examinations: (1) students must download and install the digital testing application on an approved device they'll use on examination day. All students must log in to the app with their College Board username and password to complete installation; (2) practicing with example questions in the digital testing app is the best way to prepare for digital examinations. Digital practice also confirms that students' testing computers work as expected before examination day; (3) for each digital AP Exam students take, they must complete the exam setup step in the digital testing app. This step loads the examination onto the computer they're going to test with. Completing this step is required 1–3 days before each exam. Without taking this step for each examination, students won't be able to test; (4) students are required to check in to each of their digital examinations.

OSSLT UPDATE (2021)

This week the Rainbow District School Board announced that students will not be participating in this year's OSSLT online test. As a result, students who are entering their Grade 12 year and are on track to graduate in June 2022 will have this graduation requirement waived. Students entering grades 10 and 11 in the 2021 - 2022 school year will be provided with opportunities to write the OSSLT. More details regarding the delivery of the OSSLT in the upcoming school year will be shared at a later date.

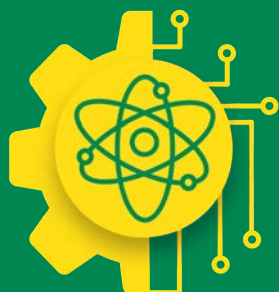
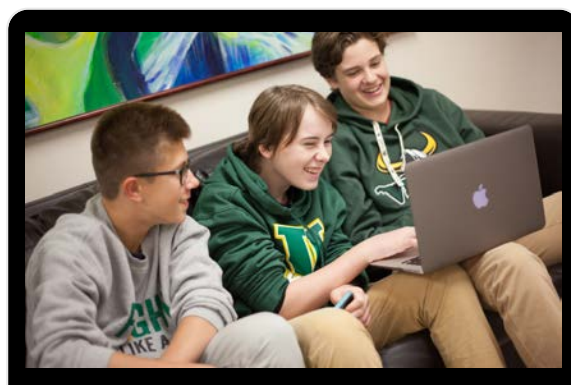
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
