


CELEBRATING LOCKERBY STAFF

AP EXAMINATIONS - GOOD LUCK!





Scholarships

Metal-Air Bursary - Friday, May 14th, 2021

For many years, Metal-Air has offered bursaries for graduating secondary students in the Greater Sudbury area. This year we will be offering bursaries in two categories: (1) Trades (students who are enrolled to attend a post-secondary institution or accepted as an apprentice in one of the 23 skilled trades) and (2) Metal-Air Employees' Dependents. OJEN's 2020 Student Bursary - Wednesday, May 26th, 2021

Are you a grade 12 student pursuing post-secondary studies that lead to a career in the justice sector? OJEN administers 22 bursaries province-wide that range from \$500 - \$1000 for students who are entering their first year of post-secondary studies in the fall.

When you submit your application, you are automatically considered for a bursary that is provided by the Association of Justices of the Peace of Ontario, the Association of Ontario Judges, and Ontario Superior Court of Judges' Association. Judges and Justices of the Peace from these three associations review all applications and select the winners. Applicants should describe the justice sector career they are interested in pursuing and demonstrate how their post-secondary program will help them achieve this goal. We hope you and your family have remained safe and healthy through these challenging times as we move through May and into June with remote learning. At this time of the year, we know that families begin to think about graduation.

As we indicated in previous correspondences, Lockerby's graduation this year, like all Rainbow schools, will be a virtual ceremony. The date has now been finalized. It will take place on Friday, June 18, 2021; this will be the release date of the video. A link to the video will be posted upon its completion on our web site, on Lockerby's social media outlets, and in the school newsletter.

Please know that more is planned for our graduating class. Information will be posted in the coming weeks detailing the pickup of a graduation memento and a graduating class composite photo. An outdoor distribution centre at the school will have gowns available for student or family photos at the end of the school year.

If graduating students have not already done so, they should join the 2021 Grade 12 Graduates Google classroom (join code 5kxbbdv) in order to find updates on the virtual ceremony and other graduation-related information. In preparation for the video, students may be asked to participate in certain parts of the recording process in order to make this as memorable as possible. However, if permitted by Public Health Sudbury and Districts, all student involvement will be subject to PHSD guidelines.

Dear AP Students and Parents/Guardians:

RE: ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) EXAMINATIONS AND FINAL EVALUATIONS

We hope that everyone is continuing to do as well as possible during these challenging times. We recognize that all families continue to face many challenges; and as we monitor this newest wave of COVID-19, from home, the health and safety of students and educators is of top priority. At this time, we would like to take the opportunity to provide you with key information and updates regarding the 2021 AP College Board examinations and final evaluations. Below is a brief synopsis of some important details:

- Given our current distance learning situations, we have made the decision to move all of our inperson examinations to the online format.
- Each course examination and final evaluation will have its own set of instructions in terms of freeanswer responses, multiple choice questions, etc. Our teaching staff will continue to reach out to students in preparation for these course-specific evaluations.
- As part of the online submission process, students will be required to download the 'AP Digital Exam Application.' Our teaching staff will provide further instructions to our students with respect to downloading this program. This program also begins to identify the steps for students to take before test day, the details of the test day experience, and the processing of scores, credit and placement. Students will need to write and submit their responses within the allotted online time.
- The College Board Testing Guides continue to be released on the College Board website, which provide further information for students about the examination day process.
- AP Research and AP Seminar courses will use additional portfolio submissions. Our staff will be communicating all portfolio submission changes and details to students.
- In the coming days, our staff will be having a lunchtime session for all AP students writing their final evaluations. Students are encouraged to attend and to ask any questions about the process, content, and preparations. As always, Lockerby Composite School teaching staff continue to communicate with students regarding this year's examinations and final evaluations as well as subject-specific changes and details.

At Lockerby Composite School, the following dates and times have been set aside for writing final examinations or final evaluations:

As usual, students' work will be scored by a network of AP College Board faculty and AP teachers, and scores will be reported on a 1 - 5 scale. The AP College Board anticipates releasing scores as close to the usual July timeframe as possible. The AP College Board has indicated that the majority of higher education institutions will continue to award college/university credit as they have in the past.

As previously mentioned, the examination and final evaluation format and questions have been designed specifically for an at-home administration. Students taking the examinations and final evaluations may not consult with any other individuals during the testing period. The AP College Board will be taking the necessary steps to protect the integrity of each examination and final evaluation administration, as they do every year. Please note, that for the small number of students who may try to gain an unfair advantage, the AP College Board has a number of comprehensive and strict set of protocols in place to prevent and detect cheating.

Know that our Viking staff has been working diligently in continuing to prepare our students for success on their 2021 AP College Board examinations and final evaluations and at this time, we would like to take the opportunity to wish all of our AP students good luck . . . we know that you will do extremely well!


REMOTE LEARNING UPDATE
