


This week our Grade 9 STEP Science students were continuing their studies in their physics unit. In Mr. Dykstra's class, our Vikings built their own batteries using copper and aluminum electrodes. After testing different electrolytes our students were able to generate up to 2.3 volts which rivals what you might find in a regular AA cell you buy off the shelf!




IT'S STILL ELECTRIFYING!

A message from your Kids Caring for Kids Cancer Drive Committee:




Boys Hockey

University: Thursday, January 13th, 2021 (\$150.00 fee for 3 programs)

College: Tuesday, February 1st, 2021 (\$95.00 fee for 5 programs)


