- 5. Enter the amount you wish to donate and fill in the required fields asking for how you will be paying, and the required demographic information
- 6. Click the green "Donate Now" button at the bottom of the page


#### How to access School Cash Online:






## **MIDTERM REPORT CARDS (S2T1)**

I have supervised Badminton, Gymnastics and Flag Football. I have also coached Reach For The Top - trivia team, and am the Support Teacher for the GSA.


## What is one piece of advice you would give to your high school self?

## What is your dream iob?


My dream job would most likely be a voice actor or a librarian, or work in a bookstore.

#### **Midterm Report Cards**

Midterm Mark Transmission to Colleges and Universities

The Rainbow District School Board will be sending marks to colleges (OCAS) and universities (OUAC) beginning Friday April 22nd, 2022. Students should review the transmission carefully to ensure the details are accurate. Special attention should be taken with regards to course codes and midterm marks. If there are any errors or questions please email Mrs. Beaudry. Students are also reminded that they must accept an offer to their chosen program carefully. The acceptance procedure is a multi-step process and must be completed with care. Each website has very specific instructions that must be followed. Students are encouraged to read the guidelines with care as well as watch training videos.

College applicants must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission by May 1st, 2022. This deadline includes students who are planning to attend the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Programs. University applicants should take note of the June 1st, 2022 date. This date is the earliest date Ontario universities may require a response to an offer of admission and a financial commitment of any kind (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit).
