MATH-TASTIC PROBLEM SOLVING

Grade 9 Mathematics students learned how to work as a team this week as they completed some group challenges. They especially rose to the challenge trying to build the tallest freestanding structure with a marshmallow on top! Some of our Grade 11s thought they should try the Marshmallow challenge too...



















AP BIOLOGY

Grade 12 AP Biology students completed an investigation where they predicted the impact of different compounds on the surface tension of water. They related this to intermolecular forces and hydrogen bonding. Understanding statistical analysis is an important part of AP Biology, so students also calculated standard deviation for each trial, and differentiated between 'differences' and 'statistically significant differences.'

Future managers and leaders in Grade 12 Business Leadership reviewed job candidates for executive leadership roles and decided on managerial suitability this week! Students used the Thinking Classrooms framework to collaborate on their assigned case.



GRADE 11 INTERIOR DESIGN

Students in Interior Design learned all about glass in their first Design Friday project. After reviewing how glass can be used in design, they learned how to properly measure, cut and grind different kinds of glass.

APPLYING THE SCIENTIFIC METHOD

This week, students in Grade 9 Science were busy reviewing the steps of the scientific method. They were performing tests to determine if the stretchability of gum relates to bubble size. Our young biologists were leaping into the new school year as they practiced taking quantitative measurements.
