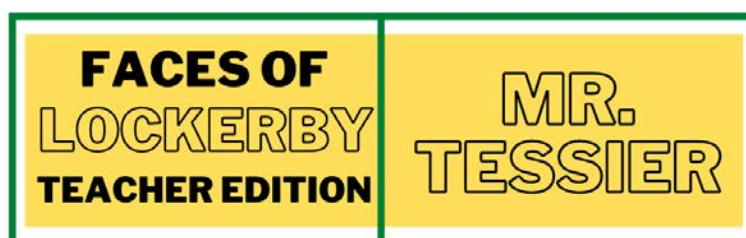

Post-Secondary Information

Getting Ready for Post-Secondary Applications

Student Services will complete post-secondary applications as soon as PIN numbers are provided (which should arrive mid to late November). Prior to completing the applications, students are encouraged to continue to research post-secondary opportunities as well as admission requirements. A number of post-secondary institutions will be hosting open houses throughout the fall and there are a number of electronic resources that can be very beneficial. Some websites to consider include the following:

- College Applications (OCAS) - the Ontario College Application Services site is now open for applications. Students can go to their website to view videos on the application process, research colleges, and complete their application. Visit - <https://www.ontariocolleges.ca/en/apply-now>

LITERACY TEST (2022)

The OSSLT Literacy Test is a graduation requirement administered by the Education Quality and Accountability Office (EQAO). The test assesses the reading and writing skills that students are expected to have learned in all subjects by the end of Grade 9, as outlined in The Ontario Curriculum.

Students who successfully pass the November OSSLT will obtain their graduation requirement and will not be required to write the test again. Students who are unsuccessful will have the options of taking a course in Summer School or signing up for the Ontario Literacy Course being offered at Lockerby Composite School during the 2023 - 2024 school year.

This year, our Grade 10 students will write the electronic version of the OSSLT the week of November 14th - 18th, 2022. They will also participate in a practice diagnostics in their Period 1 classes on Thursday, October 13th, 2022. All other regular scheduled classes will be running as usual. Students will also receive intensive support during their Day 1 Period classes as well as the opportunity to attend Tuesday's lunchtime and virtual workshops. Students with an IEP will have a meeting with Ms. Baggs after the diagnostic to review the accommodation available to them for the OSSLT. 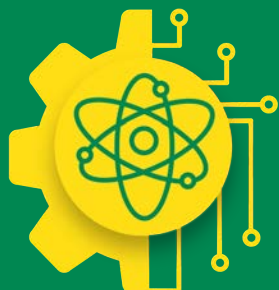
