GRADE 12 AP BIOLOGY

AP Biology students completed their bacterial transformation laboratory. In this procedure, students applied biotechnology tools to genetically modify bacteria. That's right, they inserted novel DNA into bacteria cells! We are still waiting for our results, and if the procedure was successful, the new bacteria will glow in the dark! The procedure used by our Viking Biologists is similar to the one used to insert insulin coding plasmids into bacteria, which results in insulin production in a laboratory setting.







This week, students in AP Biology also wrapped-up their stimulus - response investigation, where they examined the response of terrestrial isopods to environmental changes. This mandatory Advanced Placement laboratory is surprisingly complex, because students have to research the habits and preferences of isopods, and plan a well controlled investigation.








GRADE 12 KINESIOLOGY

College and University Applications

Many of our students have already completed and paid for their applications to post-secondary institutions. This message is a reminder that the applications have specific deadlines; it is essential for students to meet these deadlines in order to be considered for their chosen program. It is also important to note that the institutions will not receive any information until applications have been paid. Early conditional offers are starting to be provided to our students. To be considered for this first-round of offers, students must complete and pay for their application prior to the Holiday Break.

University Deadline: Thursday, January 12th, 2023 (\$156.00 fee for 3 programs) College Deadline: Wednesday, February 1st, 2023 (\$110.00 fee for 5 programs)


