We hope everyone had a restful break and we're looking forward to a great 2023! We've hit the homestretch for Semester 1!



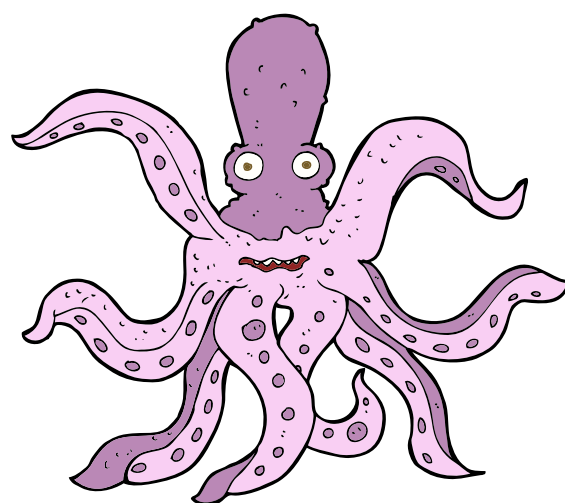
## SEMESTER 1 EXAMINATION SCHEDULE

### College and University Applications

Many of our students have already completed and paid for their applications to post-secondary institutions. This message is a reminder that the applications have specific deadlines; it is essential for students to meet these deadlines in order to be considered for their chosen program. It is also important to note that the institutions will not receive any information until applications have been paid. Early conditional offers are starting to be provided to our students. To be considered for this first-round of offers, students must complete and pay for their application prior to the Holiday Break.

University Deadline: Thursday, January 12th, 2023 (\$156.00 fee for 3 programs)

College Deadline: Wednesday, February 1st, 2023 (\$110.00 fee for 5 programs)

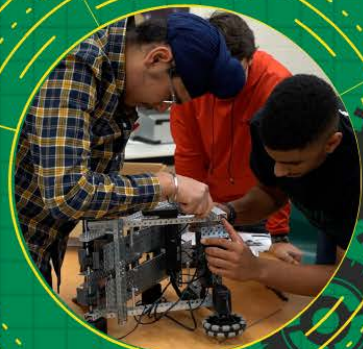

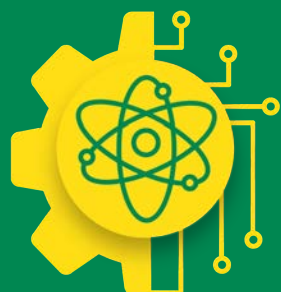
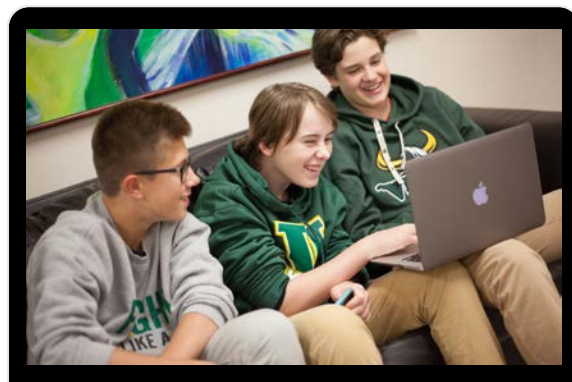
