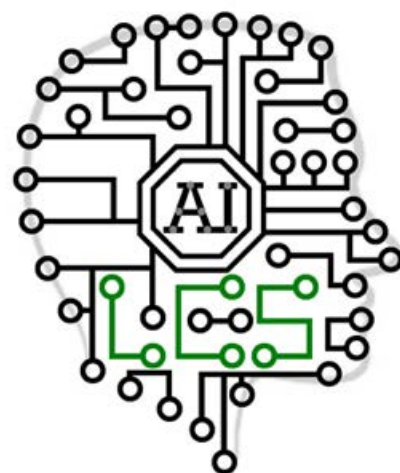
GRADE 9 ENGLISH - 'LEVANIES 2023'

OJIBWE LANGUAGE PROGRAM

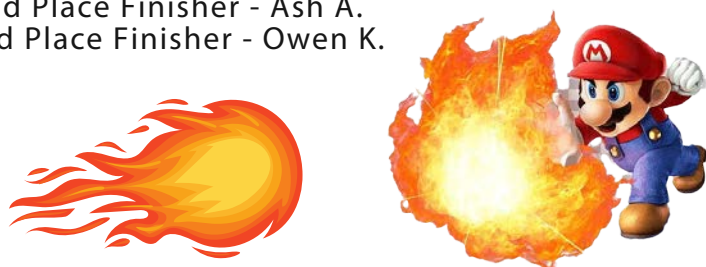

Ms. Squires and Ms. Gordon prepped the deer hide for the class and next week, our students will complete their Zhiishiigwan (Zhe-she-gwun).

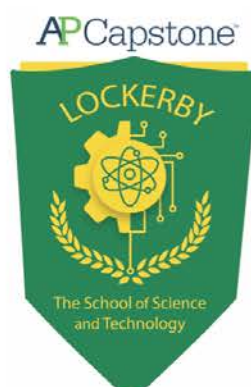
Planning for the 2023 - 2024 Academic Year

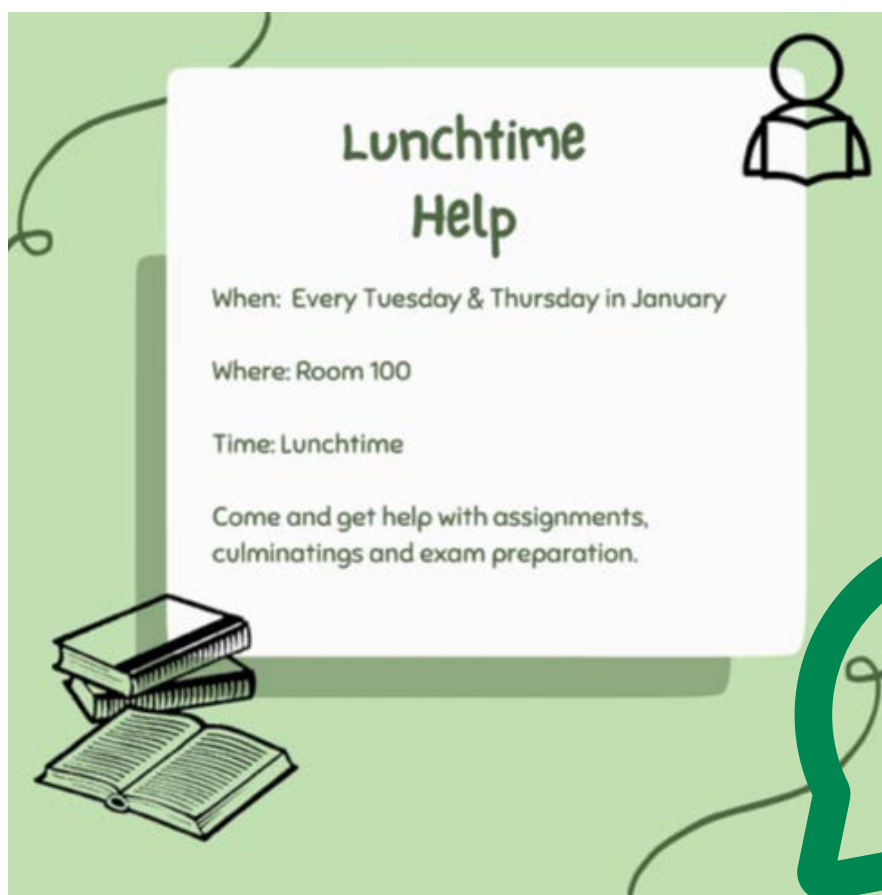
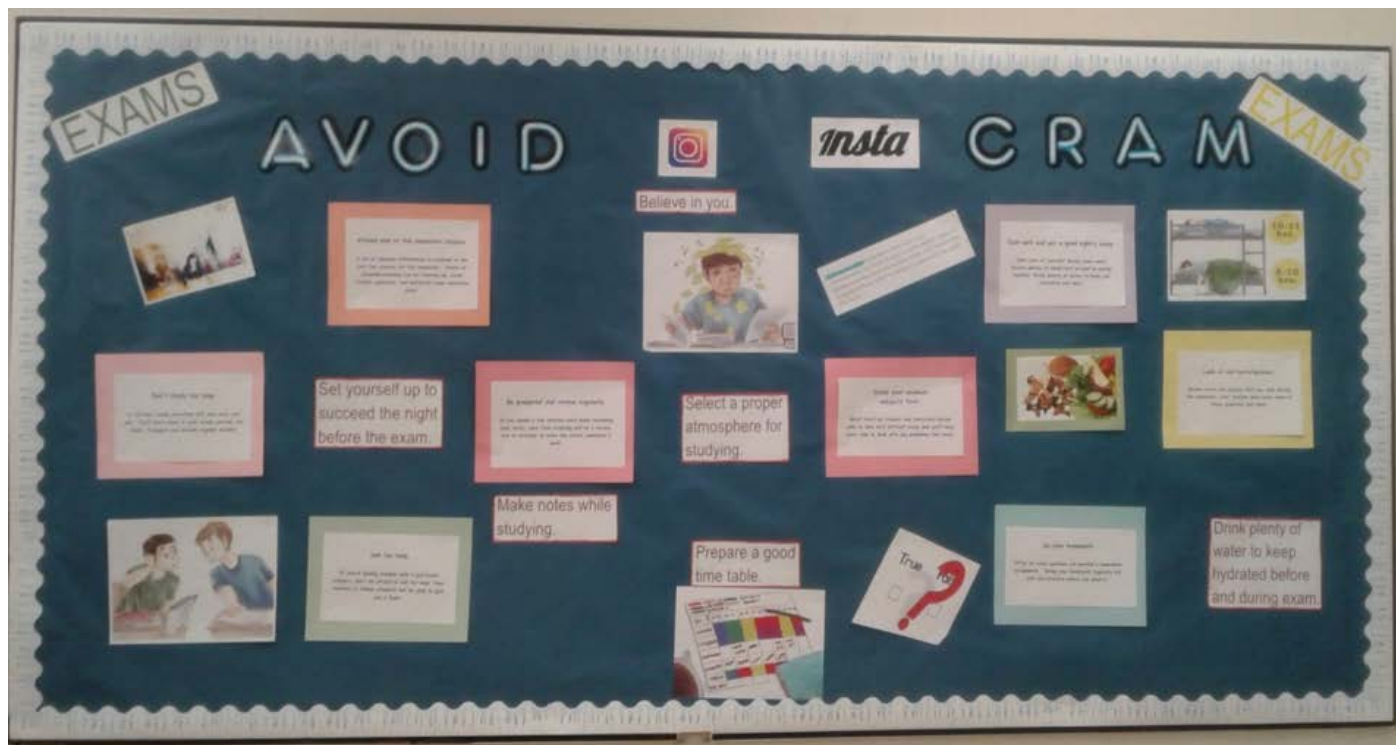
Students should arrive early to give themselves adequate time to prepare for writing their examination. Students cannot leave the examination area within one hour of examination start-time.

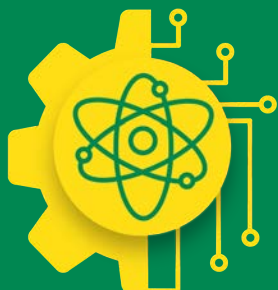
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
