GRADE 12 KINESIOLOGY








BACTERIA WEEK IN MEDICAL BIOLOGY

This week Viking Biologists toasted to our microbiomes, by completing our kombucha brewing project. Students learned about the diversity of organisms found in fermented foods, and how humans can benefit from bacteria and yeast. After brewing our kombucha for a week, many students opted to take home their scoby, and continue their probiotic adventures with their friends and families! Vikings also researched some antibacterial and antifungal plant extracts. Our intrepid students planned investigations to test the effects of different plant extracts on the growth of microorganisms. Not only did they plan an investigation, but they also learned about and practiced aseptic technique to minimize contamination of our bacteria colonies.






AP BIOLOGY - LEARNING THROUGH OSMOSIS?

The Advanced Placement (AP) Biology classes created model cells using dialysis tubing, and first learned how various molecules move (or not!) across the semi-permeable membrane. Then, students used what they learned about osmosis and dialysis tubing to design an investigation. The purpose? To help their teacher determine which sucrose solution would be best to put into hummingbird feeders. Sweet!
