

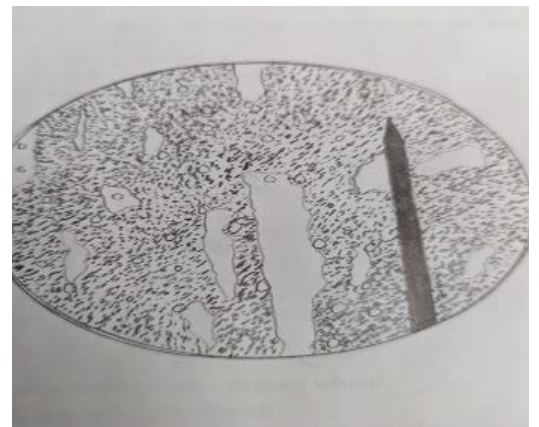

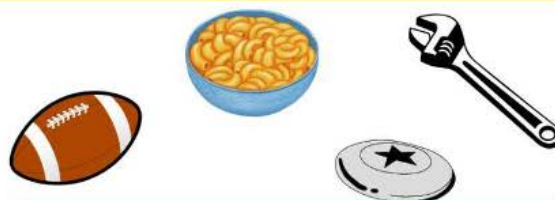

Many of our students have completed and paid for their applications to post-secondary institutions; however, there are still a number of students who still need to complete this process. It is important to ensure that application deadlines are met to be considered for a students' chosen program. It is also important to note that the institutions will not receive any information until applications have been paid.

Post-Secondary Application Deadlines

University: Monday, January 15th, 2024 (\$156.00 fee for 3 programs)

College: Thursday, February 1st, 2024 (\$125.00 fee for 5 programs)

OUAC (Ontario University Application Centre)

Transition Planning

University Applications - Tuesday, December 12th, 2023

Student Services will be hosting a university application day on Tuesday, December 12th, 2023. Students who would like assistance with their application are asked to come to Student Services during a spare period or in a class that they have received permission from the teacher at least one day ahead of the session. Students are not permitted to miss a class where there is an assessment.

Bridge To Campus - Students in Grades 10 - 12

Bridge To Campus is a non-profit organization which assists students in rural communities to access resources when applying to university. Their goal is to help high school students build connections with the students at McGill University, sharing their experiences and answering any of their questions about applying to university. Although the mentors in the organization are from McGill University, the advice and tips that are shared are ones that will greatly help students applying to any university within Canada. The one-on-one mentorship provides information and resources, free of charge.
