

#### VEX VRC TOURNAMENT AT CAMBRIAN COLLEGE


This past weekend, Cambrian College hosted Sudbury's first ever VEX Robotics tournament. Twenty teams from all over Ontario traveled to Sudbury to participate. Each team and their robot had to participate in 6 matches for the VEX game Over/Under and then in an elimination playoff. Teams could also take part in the Skills Challenge part of the game.

Lockerby sent four teams to this tournament. All four teams were participating in their first official Vex tournament. It was an exciting day with many highs. Students scrambled from one match to the other attempting small improvements in between. Hectic. Exciting. Intense. It was a demanding but fun day!

A few highlights...Lockerby was part of the first match and won! A Lockerby team was the first to lift their robot off of the ground by the slimmest of margins drawing awes from spectators. One of our team's alliances scored 173 points in a single match – the top score of the round robin! One of our teams was awarded the Team Spirit award that includes a \$2,000 scholarship to Cambrian College! We would like to thank Cambrian College for hosting such a wonderful event!






#### ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE COMPETITION

For our 4th annual Connect Four Al Competition, Grade 12 Computer Science students coded an Artificial Intelligence program that could play the game Connect Four. All student programs as well as Mr. Campeau's program were pitted against each other in a Connect Four tournament. Each Al bot played against each other Al bot 1000 times. In total, over 60,000 games were simulated. Congratulations goes out to Niko T. (3rd place), Brandon C. (2nd place), and Andrew L. (1st place). Furthermore, Andrew L.'s Al bot was pinned against past champions in the Tournament of Champions and also won that tournament! Congratulations to our new 'Super Champ!' 

Congratulations to both our Junior and Senior Girls Volleyball teams, who defeated St. Benedict's by a score of 3-0 this past week!








#### THIS WEEK IN VIKING ATHLETICS...


