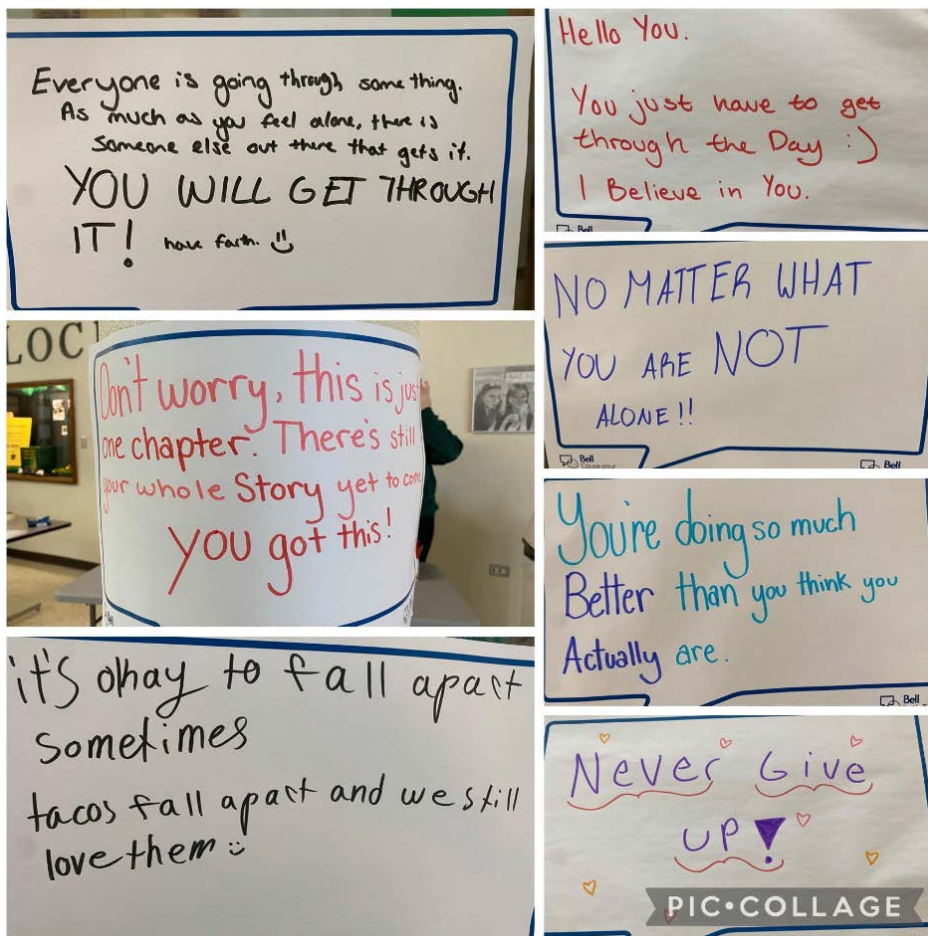


'DONUT' STRESS AND JUST DO YOUR BEST!

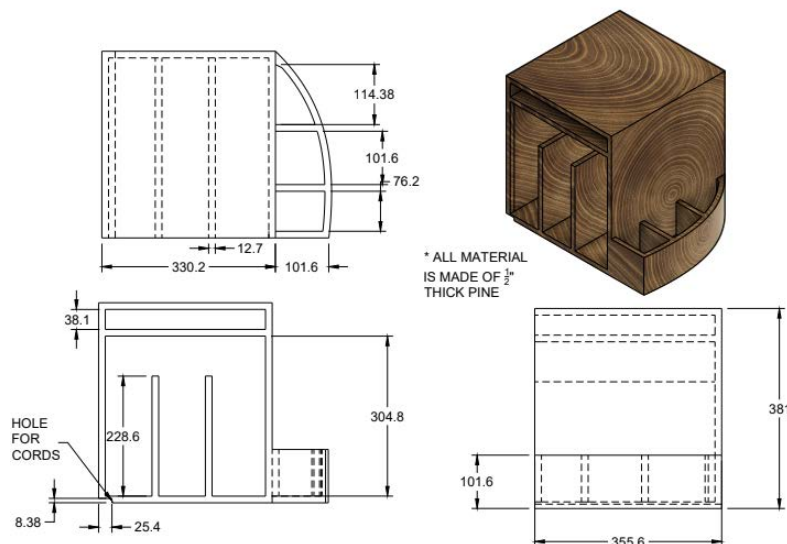





The end of our first semester is nearing completion! Culminating Activities in courses are wrapping-up and examinations have started (and will continue next following week).
