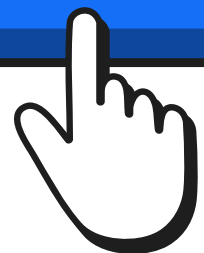
SCHOOL COUNCIL NEWS - CAREER AND JOB FAIR

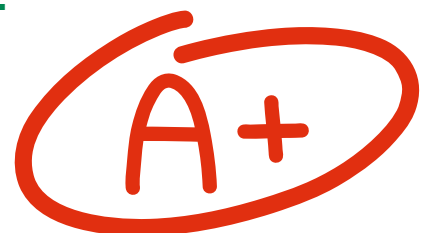

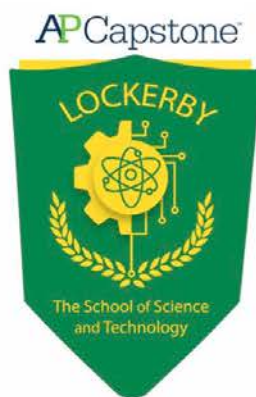

Swimming

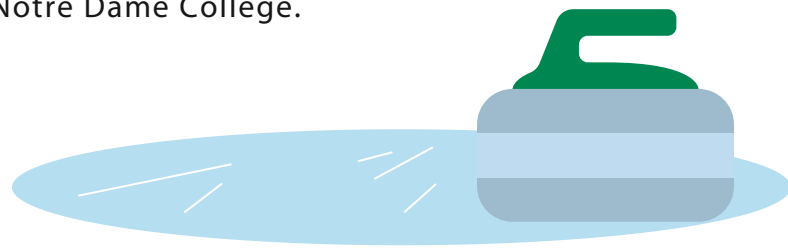

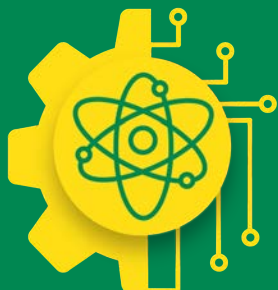
