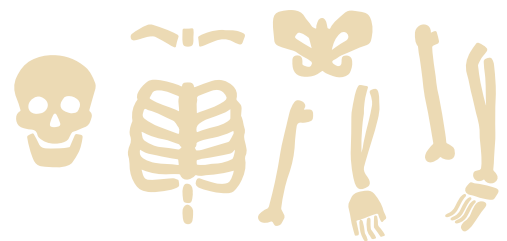
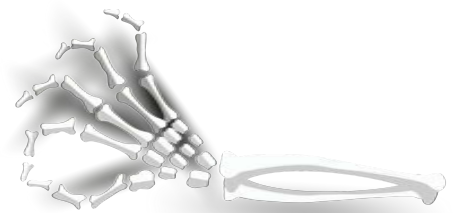

## LOCKERBY KINESIOLOGY

This week, Ms. Augenstein's Grade 12 Kinesiology class applied their knowledge of the skeletal system and proper anatomical language to study and identify the human bones of a real scientific laboratory model! Our students will be continuing their hands-on learning by using modelling clay, to build a three-dimensional model of a human joint, to gain a better understanding of the structure and function of the joints in the body.



## ACIDITY AND ALKALINITY

This week, Grade 9 Science students used cabbage juice as an effective pH indicator to test the acidity and alkalinity of various household chemicals. Cabbage juice vividly changes colours in the presence of different acids and bases, displaying many colours of the rainbow. The colour display you see was made with vinegar, Sprite, sparkling water, tap water, dish soap, and kitchen cleaner.



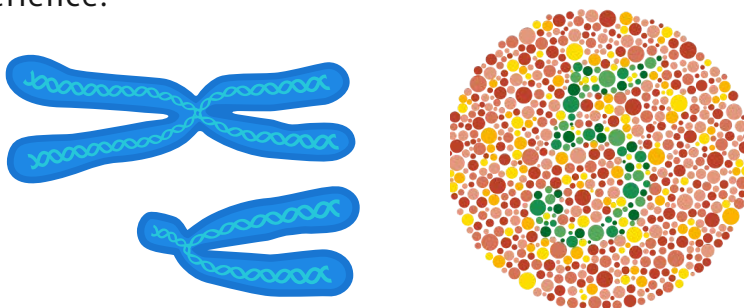
## FLAME TESTS

This week, Grade 9 Science students also examined the chemical properties of different elements by testing different chemicals under flames. Copper compounds glow a lovely green colour, while sodium (found in table salt) glows a bright yellow!



## GRADE 11 BIOLOGY

Do you see the number 5 hidden in the array of dots? If not, you may be someone who presents with protan (red-green) colour blindness. This trait is passed along on X-chromosomes and because of that, more often presents itself in people with XY chromosomes. Grade 11 Biology students took online tests this week to recognize different coloured numbers. You can see some students here tickled "red" to be part of the experience!



## VIKING YOGA!

Ms. Stanyon's Yoga class was dynamic and engaged this week, as they combined acrobatics, yoga and partner work. They created beautiful and synchronized poses, using strength, balance, and trust. Acro yoga not only builds physical strength and flexibility but also fosters teamwork, communication, and self-confidence.



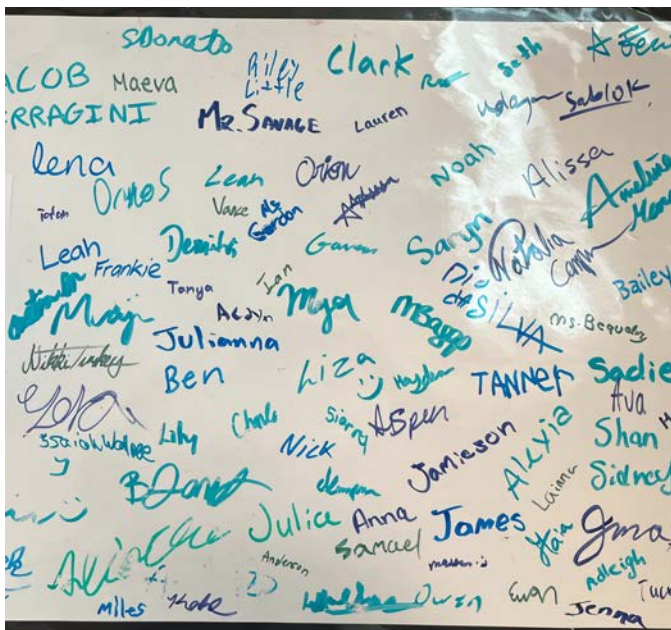
# SUDBURY MUSIC FESTIVAL

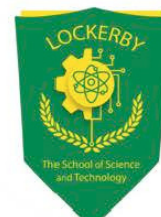

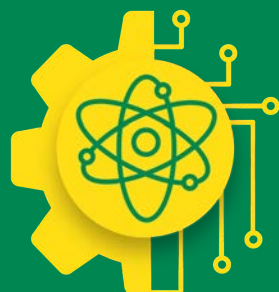
