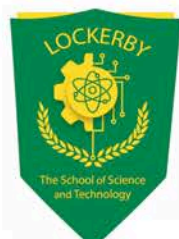
COMING THIS FALL...

Exciting changes are coming to Lockerby Composite School! As many already know, our Mathematics classrooms have been relocated to the second floor.

Over the summer, Room 115 in our 'Science Wing' will be extended and converted into a modern science laboratory. Additionally Room 150, one of our current technology shops is being expanded and redone into a 21st Century learning shop and laboratory. A 3D-printer room, fabrication space, and design-build area will be added to the traditional equipment that is in the room. Room 153 (currently known as our STEAM Room) is also getting upgraded and being converted into a STEP Integration Room and Maker Space for our refreshed Science Technology Education Program. There will also be a dedicated space for Lockerby Robotics in the room next door. Additionally, in the Fall, we have committed to also updating the aesthetics in our Library to make the space that much more welcoming for students!

Work will progress throughout the summer as we plan ahead for the 2024 - 2025 school year.

YEAR-END HOUSEKEEPING ITEMS

It goes without saying that there have been many ebbs and flows throughout the 2023 – 2024 school year, and at this time, we would like to extend our thanks to the Viking Community for their ugoing support. Having said that, and as the school year quickly comes to an end, there are a few important housekeeping items that remain:

Final Examinations

The end of the school year is only a few days away, which means that students are or have finished preparing for their final culminating activities and examinations. Each course will have different final evaluation(s) depending on its course content. For those courses with an examination, a final schedule can be found on the next page. The last day that examinations have been scheduled is Thursday, June 27th, 2024.



School Item Returns

Lockerby Composite School has loaned several materials to our Vikings students this past school year. We are asking that all of these loaned items now be returned to the school. If students have final examinations next week, they can return all items then. In order to prepare for the next school year, students are required to return items such as:



- technology (eg. iPads, chromebooks, cameras, etc.)
- textbooks / English books
- laboratory equipment
- woodworking, auto, and technological equipment
- physical education equipment/sportswear
- borrowed visual arts supplies
- musical instruments
- Library books



When returning items, students are asked to visit the Main Office. Office Staff will be on-hand to collect all materials.

Lockers

All Lockerby Composite School locks must remain on the lockers before you leave for summer holidays. During the examination period, students will be unable to access your lockers while other classrooms are writing. Books, bags, and coats will remain at the front of the classroom where you will be writing your exams.



Final Report Cards and Timetables

Grade 9 - 12 Report Cards can be picked-up at the school (Main Office) on July 8th - 9th (9:00am - 3:00pm). Graduates will also have the opportunity to pick-up any remaining graduation items as well as their transcript.

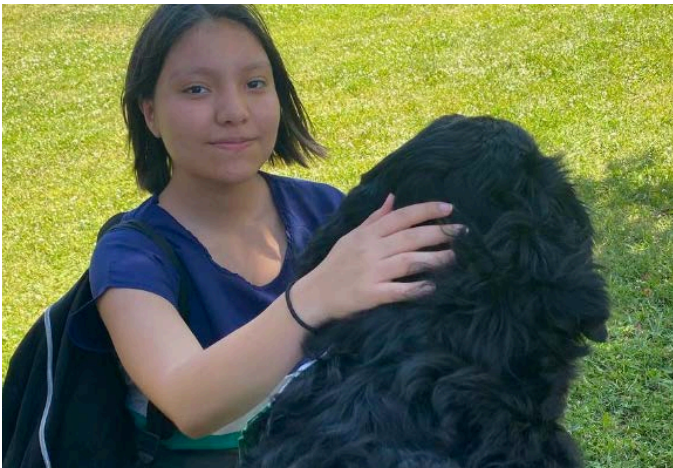

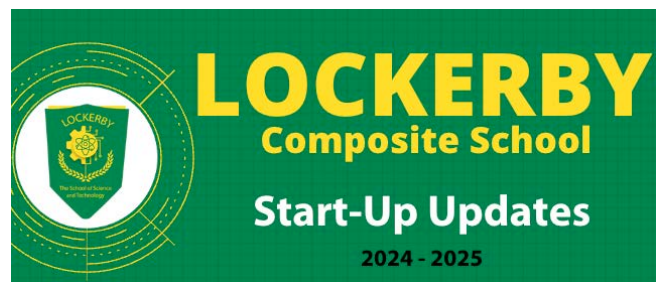
MAGICAL PET PAWS THERAPY
