SPECIALIST HIGH SKILLS MAJORS (SHSM)
















ALEXANDER GATORS VISIT



Nordic Skiing


We've got snow! This past weekend, our nordic skiers did some training...even at high elevations, the snow had eluded the team...but not anymore! Practice continues Mondays after school!



Post Secondary Applications

Applications for university and college are now open. Grade 12s are encouraged to be finalizing their plans for where they would like to apply for Fall 2025 intake. Students can research various university programs throughout Ontario as well as complete their applications at - https://www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca/. Many of our students have completed and paid for their applications to post-secondary institutions at this time. This message is a reminder that the applications have specific deadlines; it is essential for students to meet these deadlines in order to be considered for their chosen program. It is also important to note that the institutions will not receive any information until applications have been paid.

Early conditional offers are starting to be provided to our students. To be considered for this first-round of offers, students must complete and pay for their application prior to the Christmas Break.

Post-Secondary Application Deadlines

University: Wednesday, January 15th, 2025 (\$156.00 fee for 3 programs) College: Saturday, February 1st, 2025 (\$125.00 fee for 5 programs)

Transitioning to Post Secondary Presentation (College)

On Wednesday, December 4th, 2024, Cambrian College will be at our school to complete a transition planning presentation. This presentation will be a general presentation about next step planning. Students in Grades 11 and 12 who are considering college are encouraged to attend with their families. The presentation will be held in our school's library and will begin at 5:30pm.

College Applications - Tuesday, December 3rd, 2024

Student Services will be supporting students with their college applications on Tuesday, December 3rd, 2024 in the Norse Nook (Period 2). An alternative date can be arranged with Ms. Baggs or Mrs. Beaudry.

<u> University Applications - Wednesday, December 4, 2024</u>

Student Services will be hosting a university application day on Wednesday, December 4, 2024. Students who would like assistance with their application are asked to come to Student Services during a spare period or in a class that they have received permission from the teacher at least one day ahead of the session.


