




#### VEX VRC TOURNAMENT AT CAMBRIAN COLLEGE

#### **OPEN HOUSE - SEPTEMBER 2025**


Thank you to everyone who came to our Open House on Thursday night! We had a big crowd and it was a tremendous success!



With the help of retired Forensic Botany professor Dr. Gerard Courtin, one group worked on extracting metal particles from sediment cores that they took a few weeks ago in a research wetland. They are hoping to answer the question, "Did metal kill the Sphagnum moss?" Another group of students is hoping to determine changes in sediment pH over time by referring to the same wetland core samples. Awesome stuff!

Grade 9 French Immersion students were delighted by Kees B.'s presentation about meringues - enough was made to share with the whole class! Très délicieux!









Summer Company Opportunity




#### Course Selection (September 2025)
