This week in our kitchen, our senior culinists cooked some cabbage rolls, while celebrating Ukranian heritage!



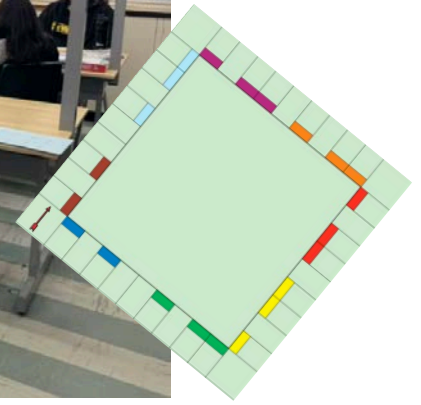
YOGA

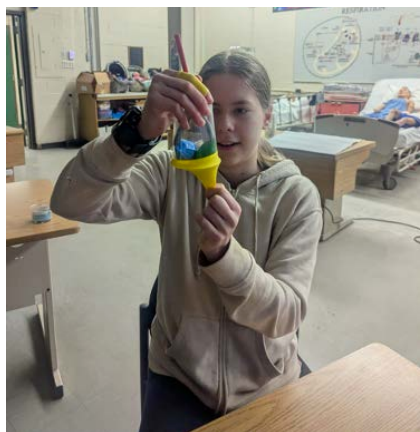
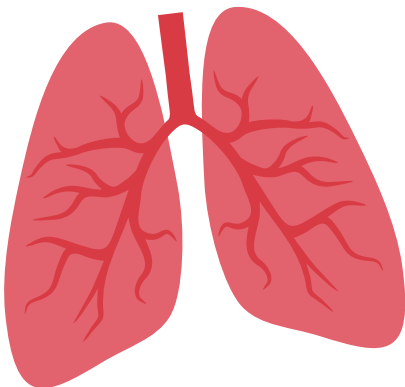
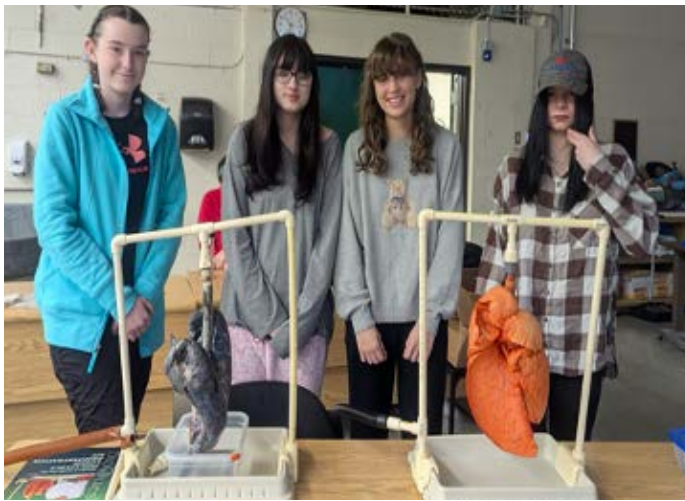
MONOPOLY ACCOUNTING

Mr. Savage's accounting class had their first day of Monopoly accounting where they tracked transactions and kept their books balanced as they became real estate moguls!



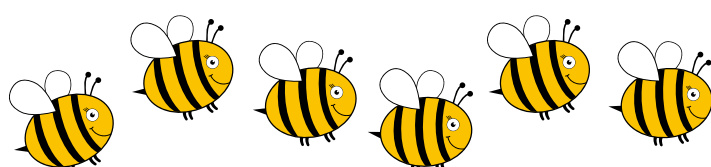
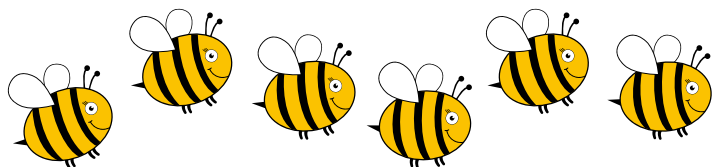
GRADE 10 SCIENCE

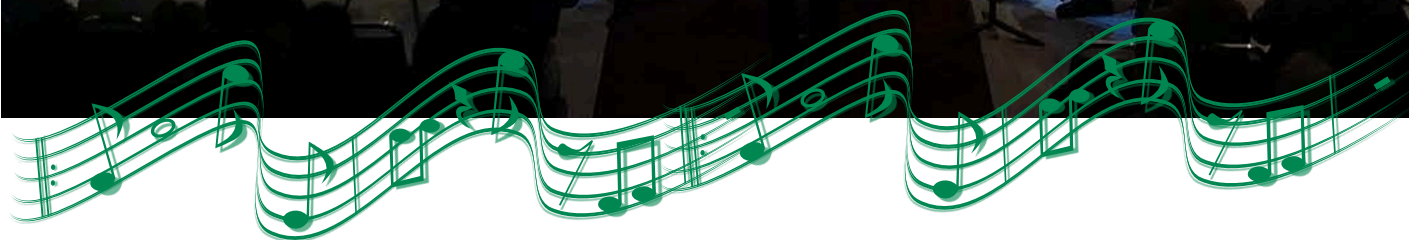
This past week, the Viking Community wore mismatched socks in support of World Down Syndrome Day.

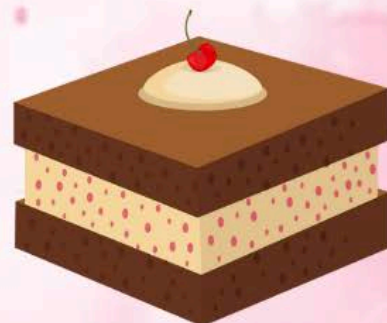

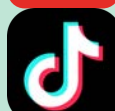

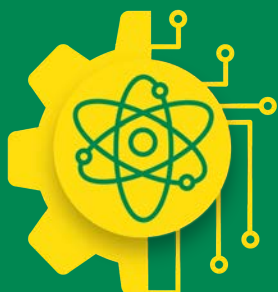
