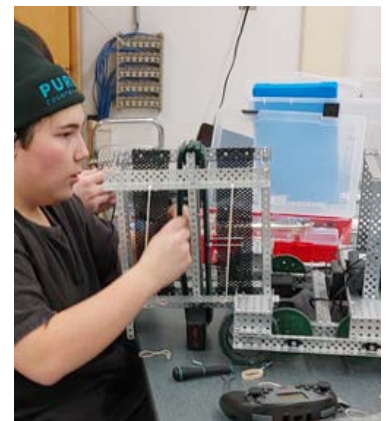
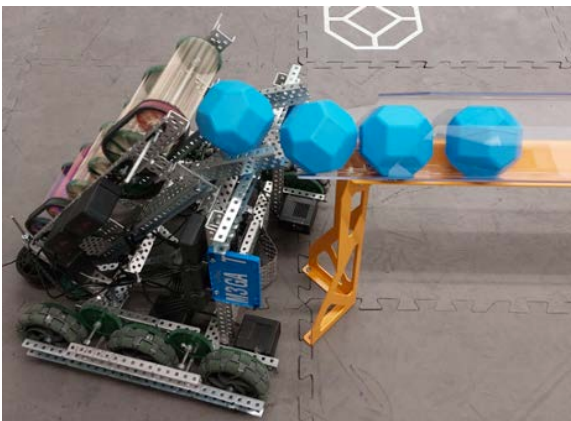


LOCKERBY ROBOTICS

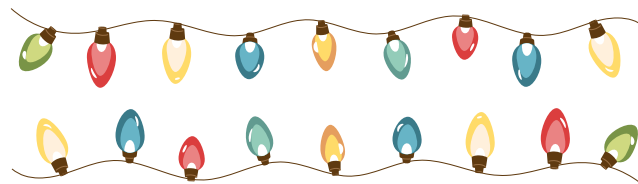
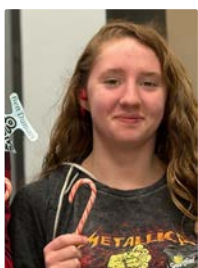

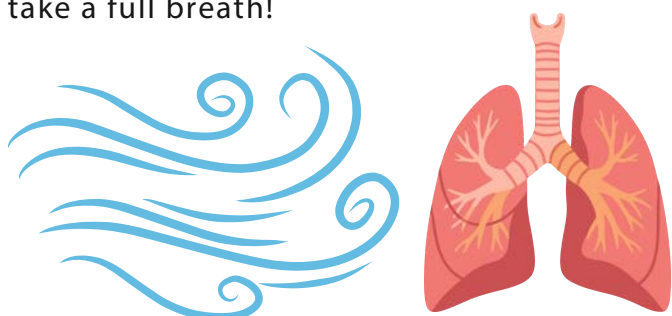
5-DAYS TO THE HOLIDAYS

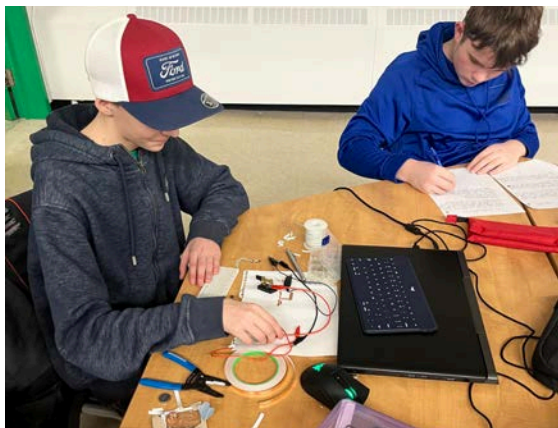
A BREATH OF FRESH AIR

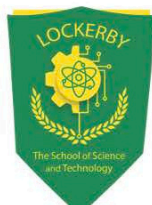

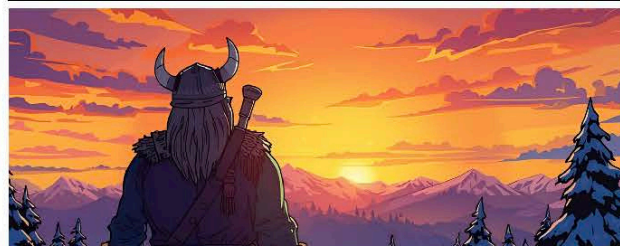

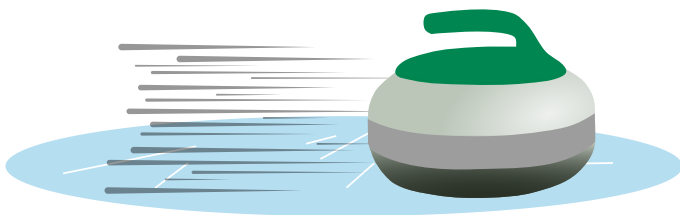
Swimming

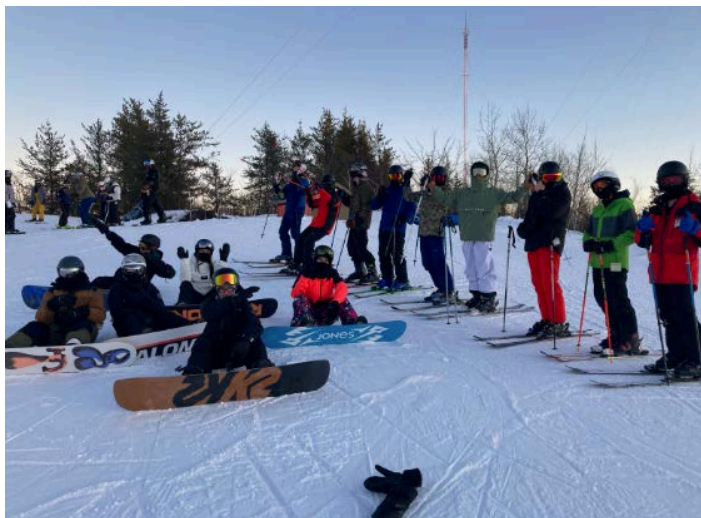

Post-Secondary Applications

Grade 12s are encouraged to finalize their plans for where they would like to apply for the Fall 2026 intake. Students can research various university and college programs throughout Ontario as well as complete their applications at - <https://www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca/> and <https://www.ontariocolleges.ca/en/>. Many of our students have completed and paid for their applications to post-secondary institutions at this time. This message is a reminder that the applications have specific deadlines; students need to meet these deadlines in order to be considered for their chosen program. It is also important to note that the institutions will not receive any information until applications have been paid for. Early conditional offers are starting to be provided to our students.

Post-Secondary Application Deadlines

- University - Thursday, January 15th, 2026 (\$156.00 fee for 3 programs)
- College - Sunday, February 1st, 2026 (\$150.00 fee for 5 programs)

Graduation Photographs

Edge Photography will be at our school to capture this year's graduation pictures from Tuesday, February 3rd, 2026 until Thursday, February 5th, 2026. Students can book the free 'Yearbook Sessions,' which include one pose, or they can choose to pay \$35 for a 'Classic Sitting,' which includes ten poses.
