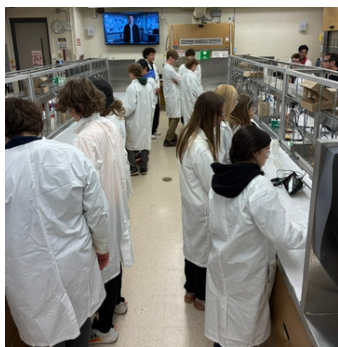
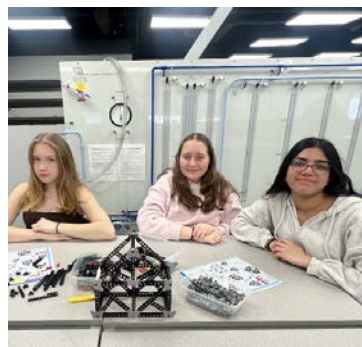

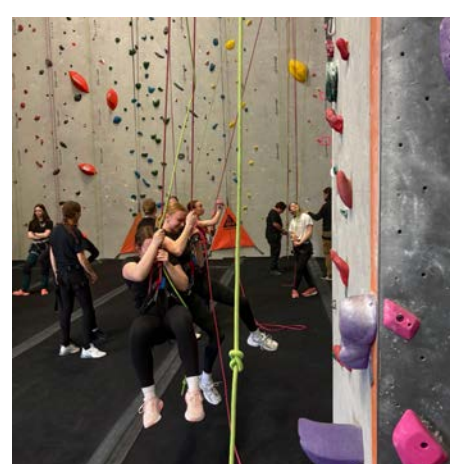
SUDBURY MUSIC FESTIVAL

GREENCOATS MEET BLUECOATS

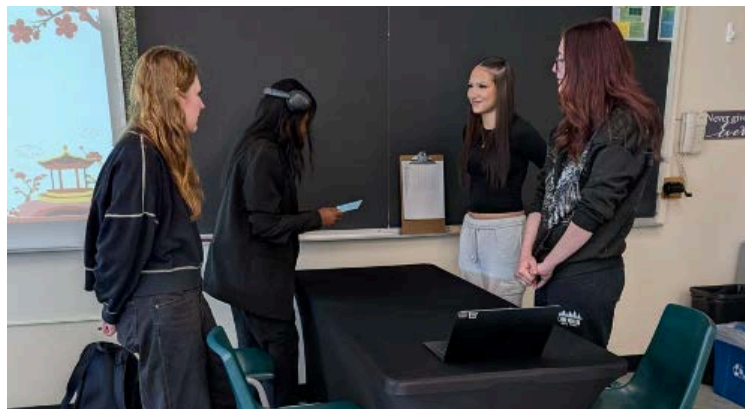

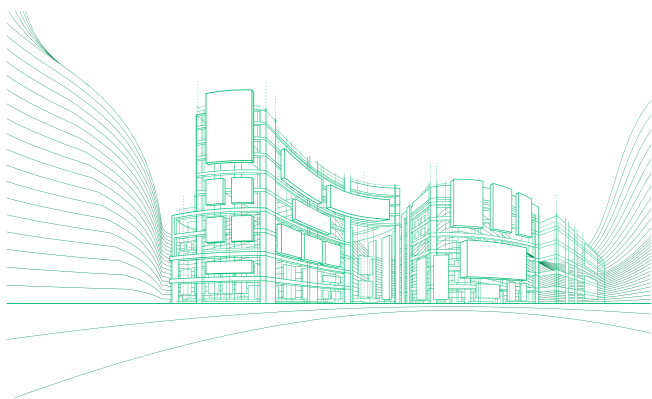
GLOBAL BUSINESS IN THE CLASSROOM

LOCKERBY ARCHITECTURE

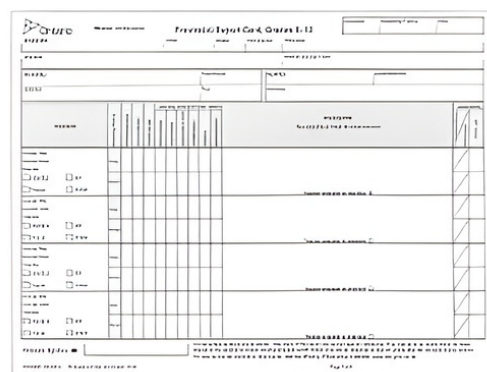

A message from Rainbow District School Board (and Lockerby Composite School)

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Rainbow District School Board is pleased to share that you can now purchase lunch for your child in any high school Chartwells Servery (including Lockerby Composite School) through SchoolCash Online. There are two options for your convenience.

Option 1

Pre-order and pay for a meal by the end of the current month for the following month (example: order by April 30, 2026 for May 2026). Meals are available on Mondays and Fridays based on a set menu for each week. Your child's meal will be ready for pick up in the cafeteria on the designated day. Chartwells is offering healthy options, with a focus on vegetables and protein. Best part - you can customize the order. No onions. No problem. You will have the option to remove them when you pre-order through SchoolCash Online. The order will be prepared and labelled for your child, so they do not have to wait in line. Important - If your child is absent on the day of the pre-ordered meal, it cannot be cancelled or reimbursed.

Option 2

Get a ZipThru card in the Cafeteria Servery and load it with money for lunch through SchoolCash Online. Your child will move through the cafeteria line quickly. Best part - no need to carry a credit card or cash.

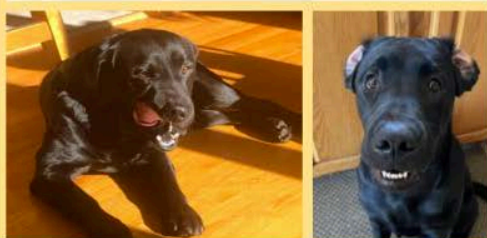
DAWSON DELABBIO

What is your dream travel destination?

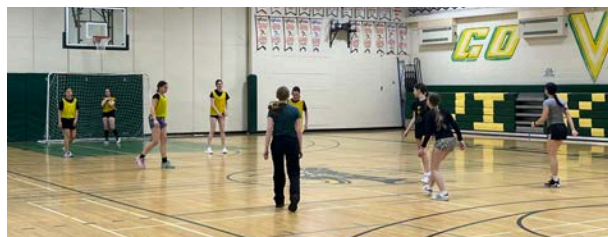
I dream of going snowboarding in the Hida Mountains in Northern Japan. I'd like to learn some Japanese while I am there.

CHILD AND YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH WEEK

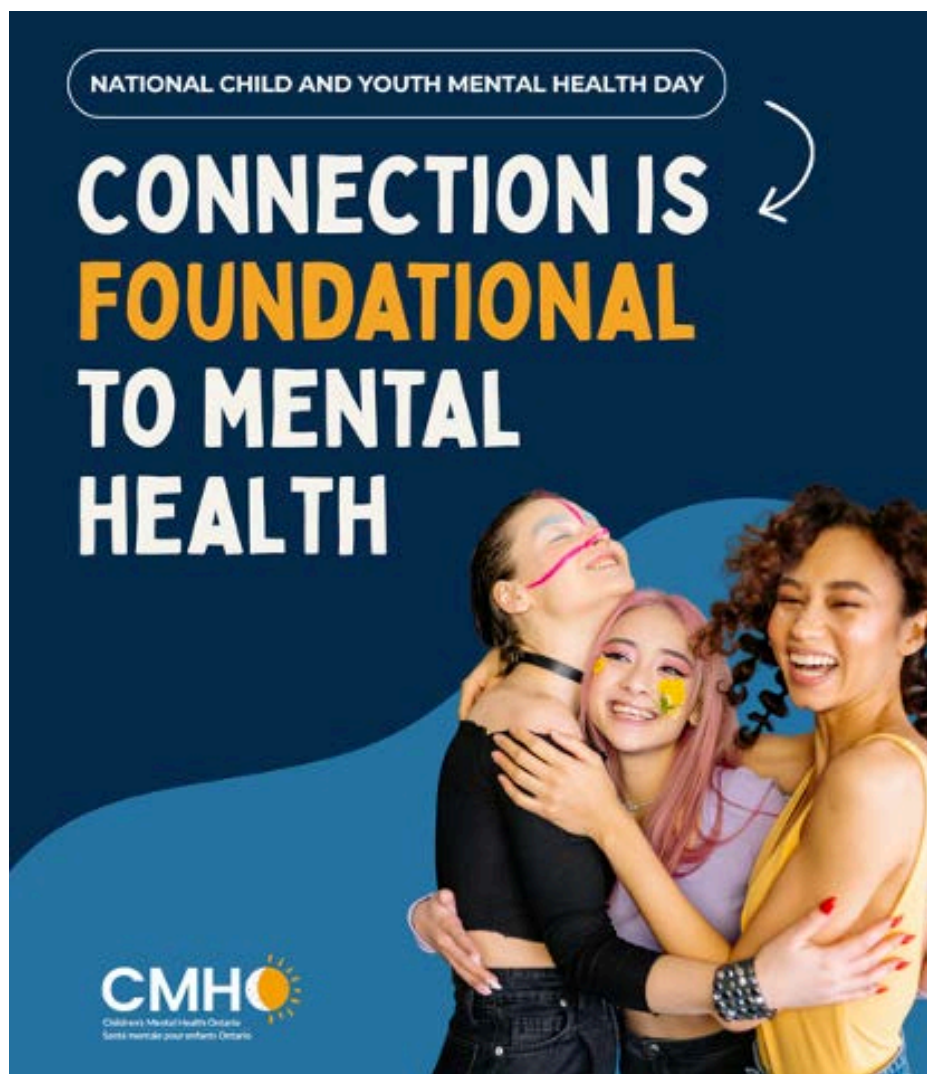

Midterm Mark Transmission to Colleges and Universities

The Rainbow District School Board sent marks to colleges (OCAS) and universities (OUAC) on Thursday, April 23rd, 2026. Graduating students should review the transmission carefully to ensure the details are accurate. Special attention should be taken with regard to course codes and midterm marks. If there are any errors or questions, please email Ms. Baggs or Mrs. Beaudry.

Accept Your College Offer – Friday, May 1st, 2026

Students should accept their college offer by Friday, May 1st, 2026, to save their seat in their chosen program. If a program is over-subscribed and there is a waitlist, students risk losing their place in the program if they do not adhere to this deadline. Students can accept their programs on the Ontario College Application website - ontariocolleges.ca.

University Applications - Important Dates As of Friday, May 29th, 2026

As of Friday, May 29th, 2026, every student who has applied to a university program will have received a response from an Ontario university. A response will be either i) an offer, ii) a refusal, or iii) a deferral pending the receipt of specific additional information. By Monday, June 1st, 2026, Ontario universities require a response to an offer and most likely a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.). Note that all other admissions-related elements, including scholarships, student assistance or financial incentives, and residence, are part of the offer of admission. Students must also log into their OUAC accounts to accept their offers; this is a multi-step process. Students will receive a confirmation number once all of the steps in the process are completed. A video tutorial for online responses is available on the OUAC website. This video demonstrates the steps required to respond to a university offer of admission. When complete the submission process is complete, a confirmation number will be sent by email along with a summary of responses to offers of admission and/or changes to your application information.

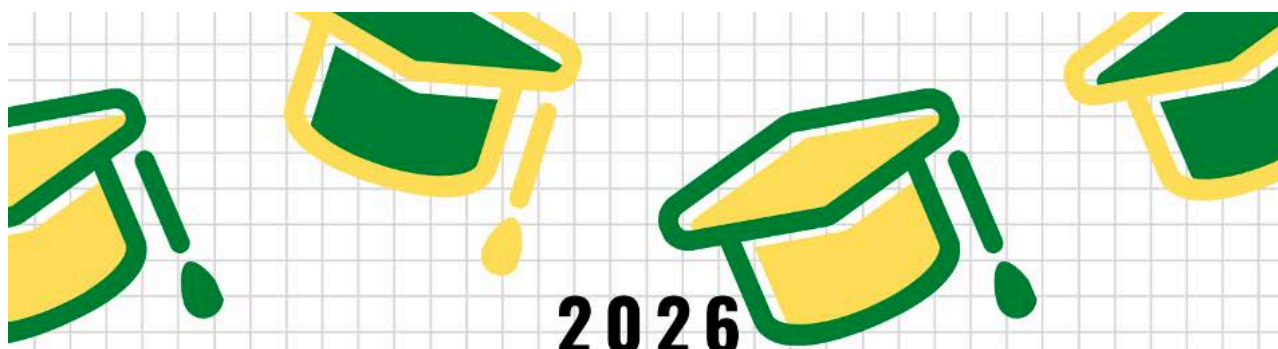

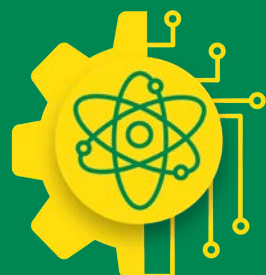
